**RESOLUTION HONORING THE OAKLAND HIGH SCHOOL WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM AS 2024 CALIFORNIA INTERSCHOLASTIC FEDERATION DIVISION V STATE CHAMPIONS AND THE OAKLAND TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL BOYS' BASKETBALL TEAM AS 2024 CALIFORNIA INTERSCHOLASTIC FEDERATION DIVISION II STATE CHAMPIONS**

**WHEREAS**, against many odds and relentless pursuit, both the Oakland High School Girls' and the Oakland Technical High School Boys' Basketball teams persevered into this incredible, defining, life moment and remarkable victory; and

**WHEREAS**, under the leadership of Coach Nita Simpson, the Oakland High School Girls' Basketball Team, the Oakland High Wildcats, won the 2024 California Interscholastic Federation (CIF) State Division V Championships for girls' basketball on March 8, 2024, defeating Montgomery-San Diego High School with a 56-50 win; and

**WHEREAS**, under the leadership of Coach Karega Hart, the Oakland Technical High School Boys Basketball Team, the Oakland Tech Bulldogs, won the 2024 California Interscholastic Federation State Division II Championships for boys' basketball on March 9, 2024, with a 79-55 win over Centennial High School in Bakersfield; and

**WHEREAS**, this year's wins by the Oakland High School Girls' and the Oakland Tech Boys' teams are reminiscent of 2023, when the Oakland Tech Girls' and the Oakland High Boys' teams won titles at the same time. Since 2016, high schools in Oakland Unified School District (OUSD) have won a remarkable 11 state championships, seven of which have been in basketball; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland Tech Girls' Basketball Team has won three titles, while the Oakland Tech Boys' and the Oakland High Boys' teams each have one title in basketball; and

**WHEREAS**, these student-athletes and their coaches, with the support of their loved ones and loving community, are a great source of pride for Oakland; and now therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the Oakland City Council commends and congratulates the Oakland High School Girls' Basketball Team, the Oakland Technical High School Boys' Basketball Team, and the OUSD staff for their accomplishments, passionate devotion, and commitment to excellence in athleticism. Let us all celebrate our 2024 CIF Division V State Champions and our 2024 CIF Division II State Champions!
