RESOLUTION NO. C.M.S.

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE PUBLIC ART ANNUAL PLAN FOR CY 2003

WHEREAS, in February 1989, the City of Oakland adopted a Public Art Ordinance (Ordinance No. 11086 C.M.S.), authorizing the allocation of 1.5% of municipal capital improvement project costs for the commissioning of public artwork; and

WHEREAS, the Public Art Ordinance requires the Craft and Cultural Arts Department to submit a Public Art Annual Plan for approval to the Cultural Affairs Commission and the City Council, which describes a prioritized list of public art projects to be undertaken in the course of the year; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Public Art Ordinance to provide a means for the City to commission artists to enliven, enhance, and enrich the visual environment of the City of Oakland through public artwork; and

WHEREAS, the Public Art Advisory Committee and Public Art Program staff have worked in conjunction with other City staff to develop an Annual Plan for CY 2003 for the commissioning of public art projects; and

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2003, the Public Art Advisory Committee unanimously approved the Public Art Annual Plan for CY 2003; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2003, the Public Art Coordinator presented the Annual Plan in the form of an informational report to the Parks & Recreation Advisory Commission, which unanimously endorsed the Plan, and passed a motion in support of the Artwork Maintenance Fund provision; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Affairs Commission unanimously approved the Public Art Annual Plan for CY 2003 at its public meeting on January 27, 2003; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby adopt the Public Art Annual Plan for CY 2003.
