RESOLUTION No. 80379 C.M.S.

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPROPRIATE TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$2,377,050.00) IN INTEREST EARNINGS FROM THE 2000 AND 2002 EQUIPMENT MASTER LEASE-PURCHASE AGREEMENTS TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF SIXTY-NINE REPLACEMENT MARKED POLICE PATROL VEHICLES
WHEREAS, in FYs 1999-2000 and 2001-2003 the City Council and the Oakland Joint Powers Financing Authority approved tax-exempt, private-placement leases for \$28,800,000 and \$14,900,000 to finance the acquisition of vehicles/equipment; and
WHEREAS, the City has accrued \$2,382,132.52 in interest income on the lease financing as of November 30, 2006; and
WHEREAS, Broadway Motors Ford, an Oakland vendor, agreed to sell 69 2007-model year Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors at its 2001 bid award price if ordered prior to the model year cut-off date of March 1, 2007; and
WHEREAS, using the interest income to pay for 69 marked police patrol vehicles due for replacement in 2003-05 will reduce the amount of the FY 2007-09 lease financing; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED : That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to appropriate \$1,601,812.00 in interest income from the 2000 Equipment Master Lease-Purchase Agreement and \$775,238.00 in interest income from the 2002 Equipment Master Lease-Purchase Agreement to cover the cost of replacement vehicles and equipment; and be it
FURTHER RESOLVED: That the interest income is appropriated to the Equipment Fund, Equipment Administration Organization, Vehicle Replacements Account (4100/30541/57612).
