ORDINANCE NO. 12519 C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING FOR THE 2004 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS THE CITY OF OAKLAND'S LIMITED PUBLIC FINANCING PROGRAM (CHAPTER 3.13 OF THE OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE)

WHEREAS, in 1999, the City Council enacted the Limited Public Financing Act and created the Election Campaign Fund,

WHEREAS, the City is currently facing a severe budget crisis during the 2003-05 fiscal years, including a \$48.3 million dollar funding gap and the proposed elimination of two-hundred-and-eleven City associate positions; and

WHEREAS, critical services such as Community Policing, Recreation Programs and Library Books may be cut if the City Council appropriates the recommended \$440,000 of General Fund money to the Election Campaign Fund.

Now therefore be it ordained:

- 1. Section 3.13.280, which reads as follows, is added to Chapter 3.13 of the Oakland Municipal Code:

"Chapter 3.13 of this Code (Sections 3.13.010 – 3.13.260 inclusive) shall have no effect for the 2004 general and runoff municipal elections."
