RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED SIXTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND THREE DOLLARS (\$116,603) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, **NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF** JUSTICE. **FOR CONTINUED** IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PAUL COVERDELL FORENSIC SCIENCE IMPROVEMENT GRANTS PROGRAM, AND APPROPRIATE SAID FUNDS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in the amount of \$116,603 will be awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, National Institute of Justice, for the continued implementation of the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program (Coverdell) in the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Department's Coverdell Program is designed to provide forensic personnel with equipment and supplies geared toward improving forensic laboratory services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 80576 C.M.S., dated May 15, 2007, Resolution No. 79765 C.M.S., dated March 7, 2006, and Resolution No. 79501 C.M.S., dated October 4, 2005, and

WHEREAS, the grant term for the proposed Coverdell grant program is October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to accept and appropriate grant funds in the amount of \$116,603 from the U.S. Department of Justice, National Institute of Justice, and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That grant funds shall be maintained in the Federal Grant Fund (2112), Criminalistics Division Org. (102610), Criminalistics Division Program (PS05), in a Project Account to be determined; and be it
