Dear President De La Fuente and Members of the Council:

The California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) requires any City that receives grant funds administered by Caltrans to adopt a "blanket" resolution delegating authority to specific staff to execute funding agreements. The recent transfer of the Public Works Design and Construction Services Division to the Community and Economic Development Agency (CEDA) requires revision of the City's current blanket resolution (Resolution No. 76870 C.M.S., copy attached) to amend the list of titles of those who may execute funding agreements with CalTrans.

Council approval of the attached resolution will enable the above referenced personnel to execute any agreements with CalTrans related to project funding. These include master agreements, program supplemental agreements, fund exchange agreements, fund transfer agreements and any amendments thereto with CalTrans. Prior to City staff signing any specific agreement with CalTrans, a separate report and resolution that authorizes staff to apply for, accept, and appropriate project-specific transportation grant funds will go through the Committee/Council process for approval.
