**RE:** Appointment of Three New Members to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission

The Mayor's Office respectfully requests City Council consideration for the appointment of three new members to fill existing vacancies on the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission (BPAC).

The BPAC continues to play a vital role in providing independent guidance on bicycle and pedestrian planning, safety initiatives, infrastructure priorities, and community mobility needs. Filling these vacancies will restore the commission to full capacity and ensure thorough review of projects, policies, and plans that impact active transportation throughout our community.

**Proposed Actions:**

- Appoint three qualified members to fill vacant BPAC seats
- Ensure comprehensive analysis and review of bicycle and pedestrian-related matters
