**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF \$30,000

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland is required by City Charter to provide televised legislative coverage to the citizens of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, KTOP, the official government access cable television station, was established to provide such coverage; and

WHEREAS, the equipment necessary to produce and distribute a live cable signal to the cable operator's headend from the Oakland City Hall has not been replaced and is past its useful life; and

WHEREAS, this equipment is no longer reliable in providing a live signal of legislative proceedings to cable subscribers, as required by local ordinance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council approve \$30,000 from the Emergency Contingency Fund for KTOP critical equipment repairs.
