RE: **Supplemental Report to the Resolution Waiving The Competitive Bid Process And Authorizing The City Administrator To Negotiate New Prices And Increase The Construction Contract With McGuire And Hester For The Resurfacing Of Certain Streets In The City Of Oakland For Fiscal Year 2003-2004 (Project No. C234930) By An Amount Not-To-Exceed \$2,000,000.00 For A Total Contract Amount Not-To-Exceed \$7,100,000.00**


SUMMARY

This supplemental report responds to the Rules and Legislation Committee request on September 14, 2006, for a list of streets to be resurfaced under this proposed contract change and streets to be resurfaced on upcoming contracts.

Attachment A is a preliminary list of the streets in the worst condition that are proposed for rehabilitation under this contract, using additional funds approved by the City Council during the fiscal year 2006-07 mid-cycle budget review. This list is offered for Council member review and input. A final list of streets will be developed based on rehabilitation cost, consultation with each Council office, and available funding allocated to each Council District.

Attachment B is a list of streets proposed to be rehabilitated in the next upcoming street resurfacing contracts for fiscal year 2006-07. These contracts are being finalized for bidding in fall 2006, contract award by winter 2006 and construction start in spring/summer 2007.


