**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL, FOR A ONE-YEAR ALCOHOL CONTROL ENFORCEMENT PROJECT WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF SAID INITIATIVE**

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that grant funds in an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) will be received from the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, for a one-year Alcohol Control Enforcement Project within the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, these State of California grant funds are to be used to expand law enforcement efforts to address alcohol-related problems through a comprehensive alcohol beverage control program within the City of Oakland; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department's primary goal through the Alcohol Control Enforcement Project is to identify and prevent the unlawful sale of alcoholic beverages and the illegal sale of alcohol to minors; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed grant does not allow for any indirect costs (Central Services Overhead) charges in the amount of \$16,872, and the Department has requested a waiver of said charges; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 78554 C.M.S. dated May 18, 2004; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept up to \$100,000 in grant funds from the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control and appropriate said funds to the Police Department; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the funds shall be maintained in the State of California Grant Fund: 2159; Vice/Narcotics Org.: 105622; Alcoholic Beverage Action Team Program PS12; with a Project Number to be established; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That Central Services Overhead costs of \$16,872 (17.77%) are hereby waived; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee is authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** that upon approval of the grant to the City of Oakland, the State of California will issue a contract for services for implementation of the initiative, and that the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to enter into said agreement in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the implementation of the Alcohol Control Enforcement Project.

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney shall review and approve said agreement with the State of California as to form and legality and a copy of the fully executed agreement shall be placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk.


