RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL, FOR A ONE-YEAR ALCOHOL CONTROL ENFORCEMENT PROJECT WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF SAID INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) will be received from the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, for a one-year Alcohol Control Enforcement Project within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, these State of California grant funds are to be used to expand law enforcement efforts to address alcohol-related problems through a comprehensive alcohol beverage control program within the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department's primary goal through the Alcohol Control Enforcement Project is to identify and prevent the unlawful sale of alcoholic beverages and the illegal sale of alcohol to minors; and

WHEREAS, the proposed grant does not allow for any indirect costs (Central Services Overhead) charges in the amount of \$16,872, and the Department has requested a waiver of said charges; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 78554 C.M.S. dated May 18, 2004; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept up to \$100,000 in grant funds from the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control and appropriate said funds to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the funds shall be maintained in the State of California Grant Fund: 2159; Vice/Narcotics Org.: 105622; Alcoholic Beverage Action Team Program PS12; with a Project Number to be established; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That Central Services Overhead costs of \$16,872 (17.77%) are hereby waived; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** that upon approval of the grant to the City of Oakland, the State of California will issue a contract for services for implementation of the initiative, and that the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to enter into said agreement in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the implementation of the Alcohol Control Enforcement Project.

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney shall review and approve said agreement with the State of California as to form and legality and a copy of the fully executed agreement shall be placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk.
