



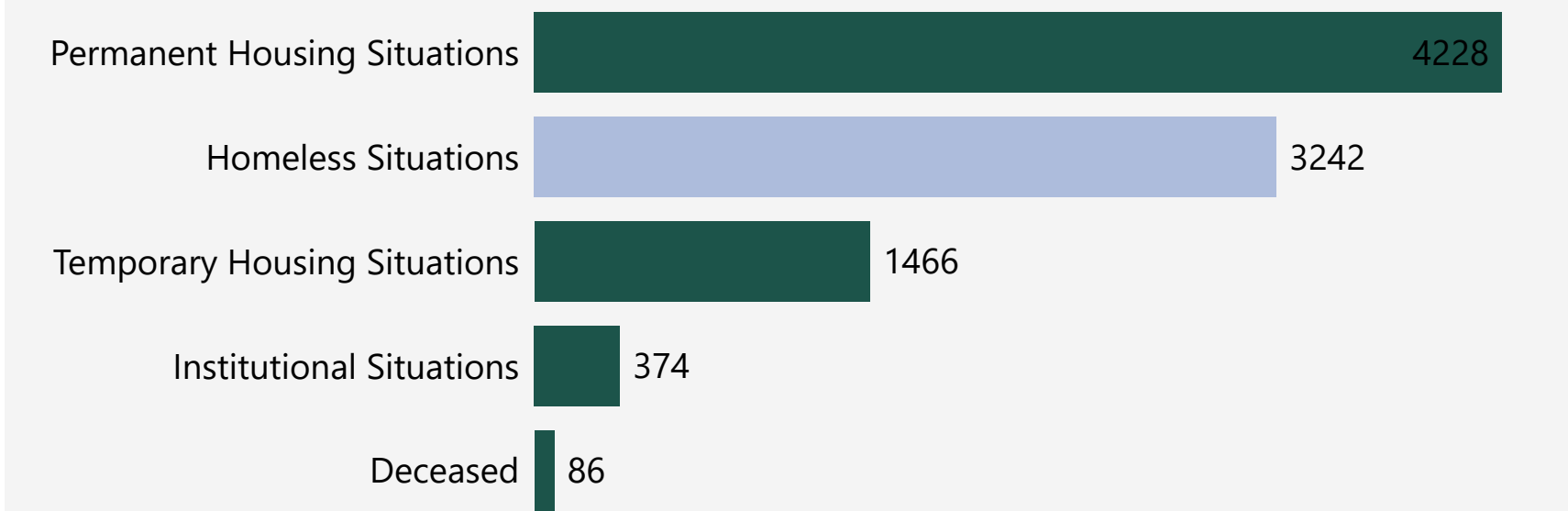
Who do our homeless programs serve?

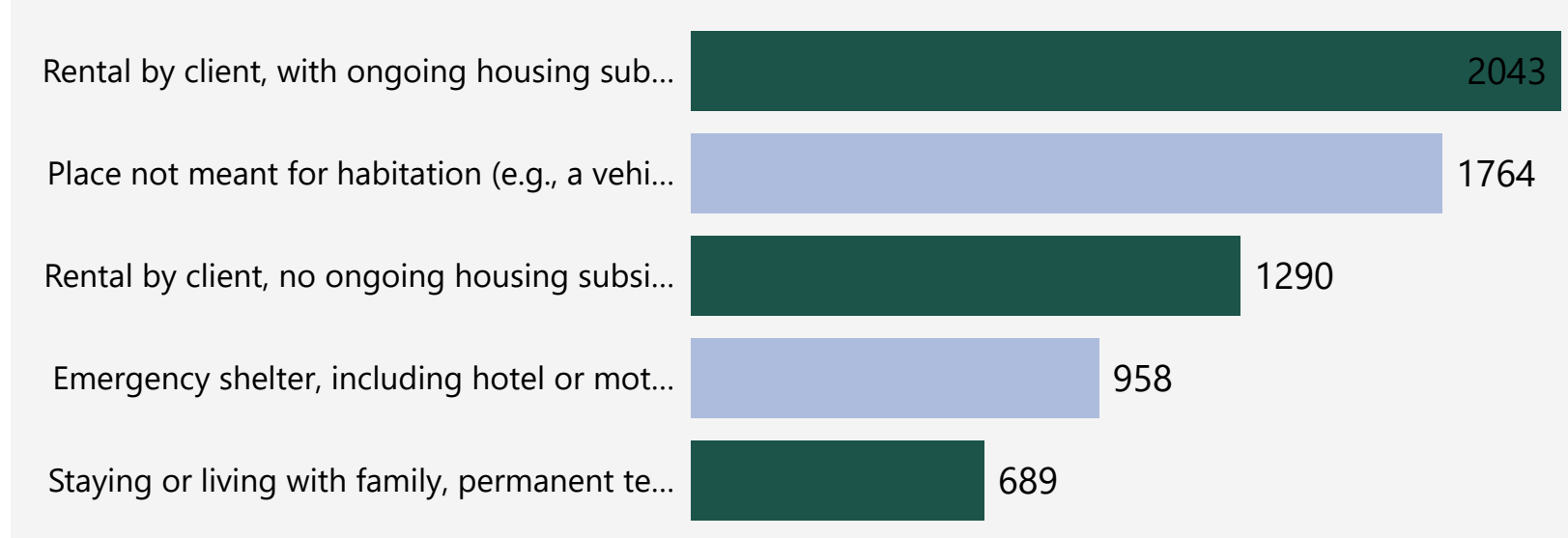

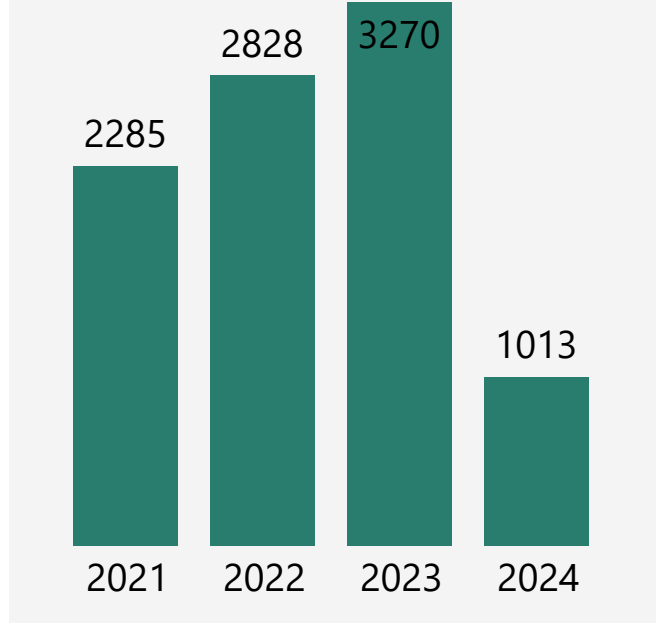
Exits by Destination



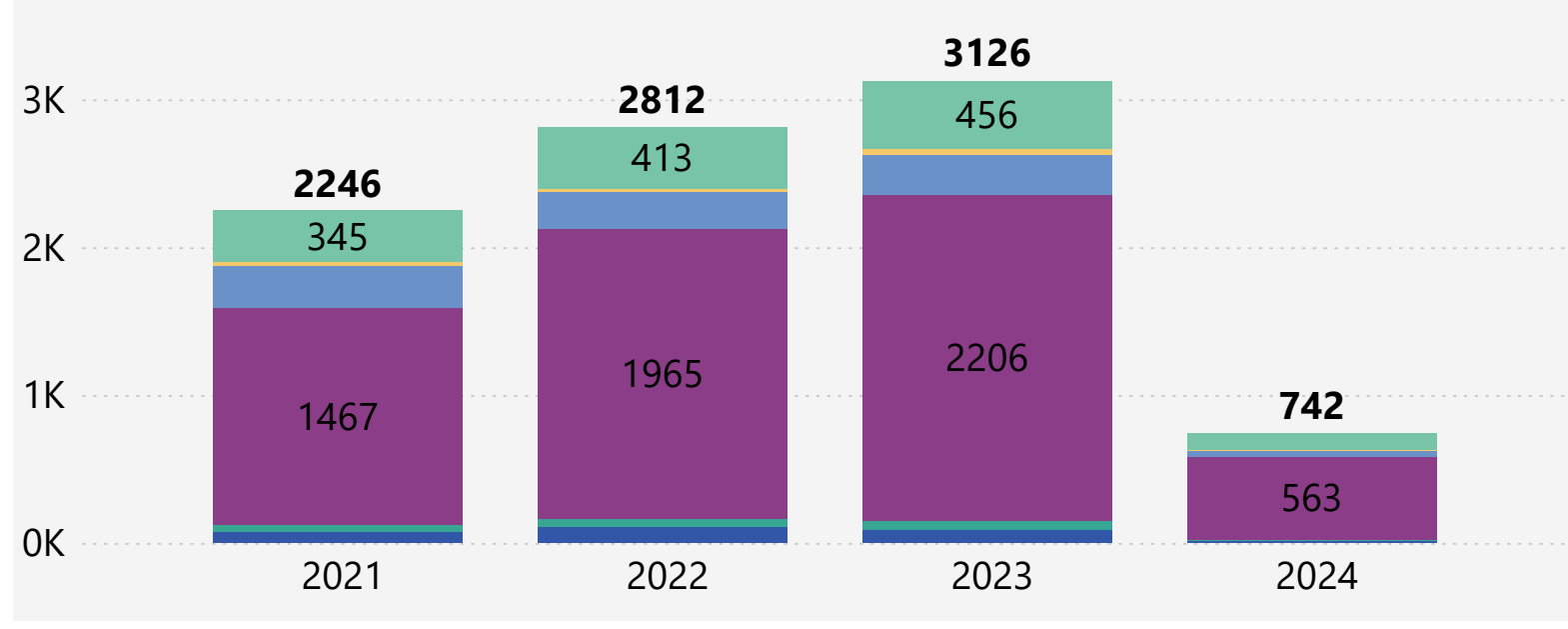
Exits by Destination (top 5)



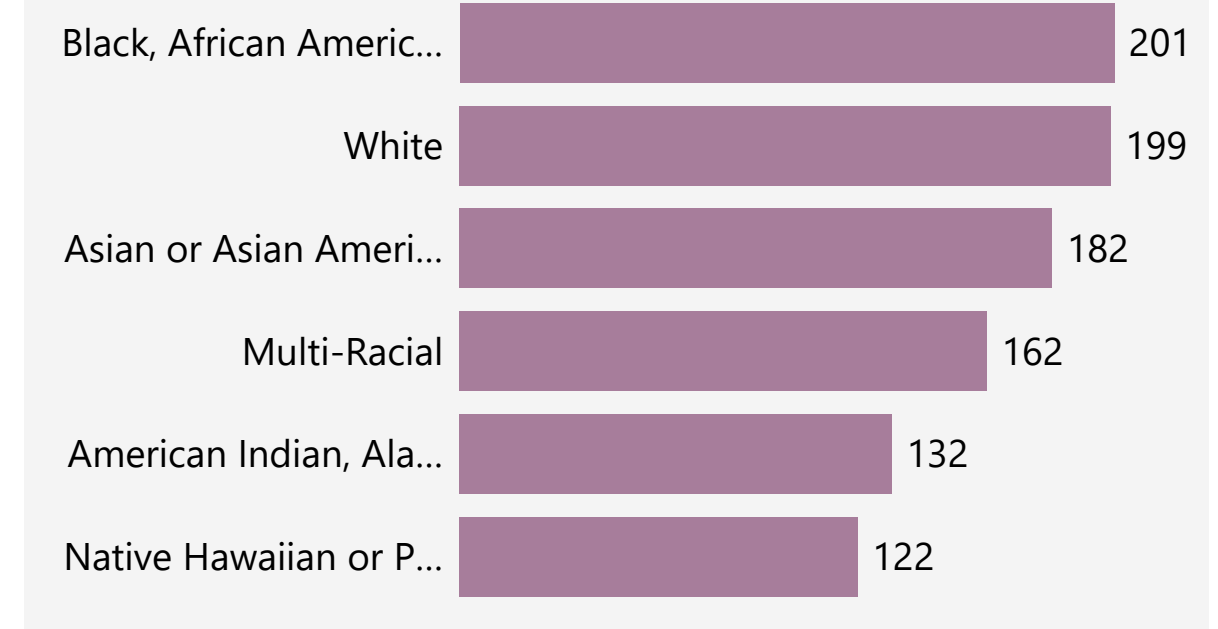
Exits by Year



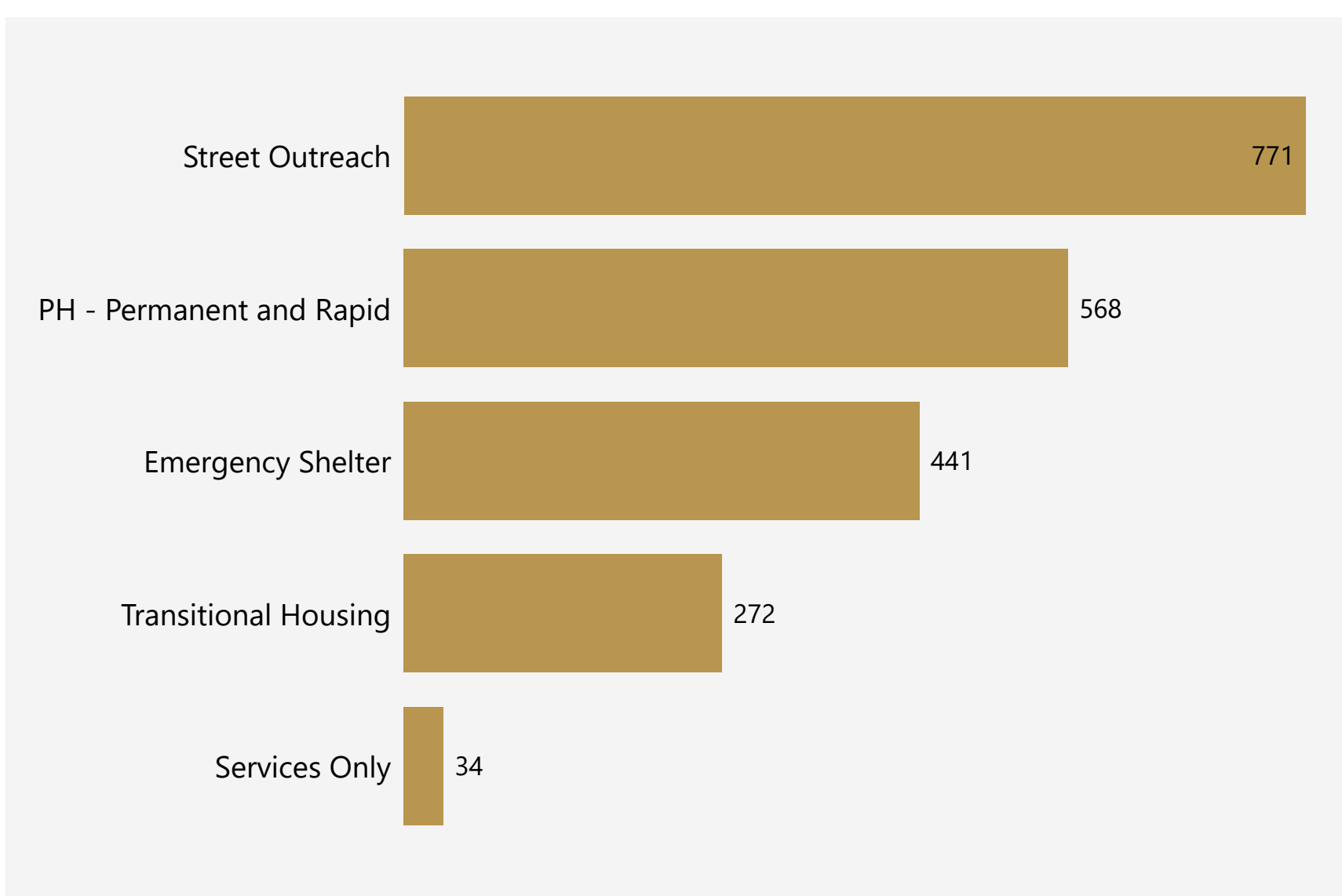
Exits by Year and Race



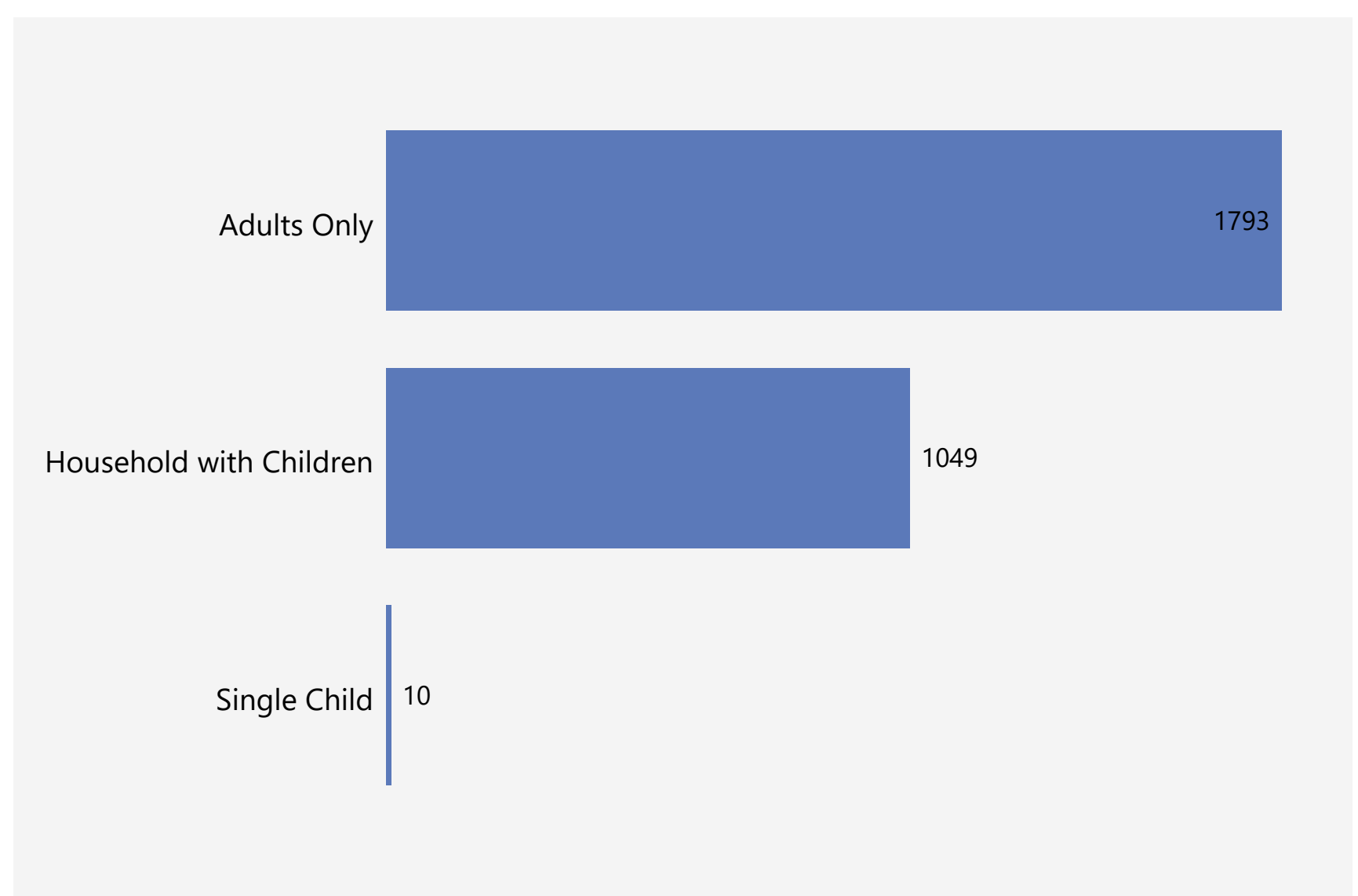
Average Length of Stay (days) by Race

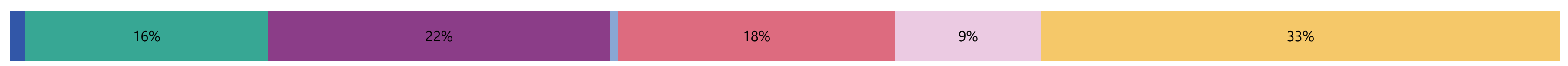

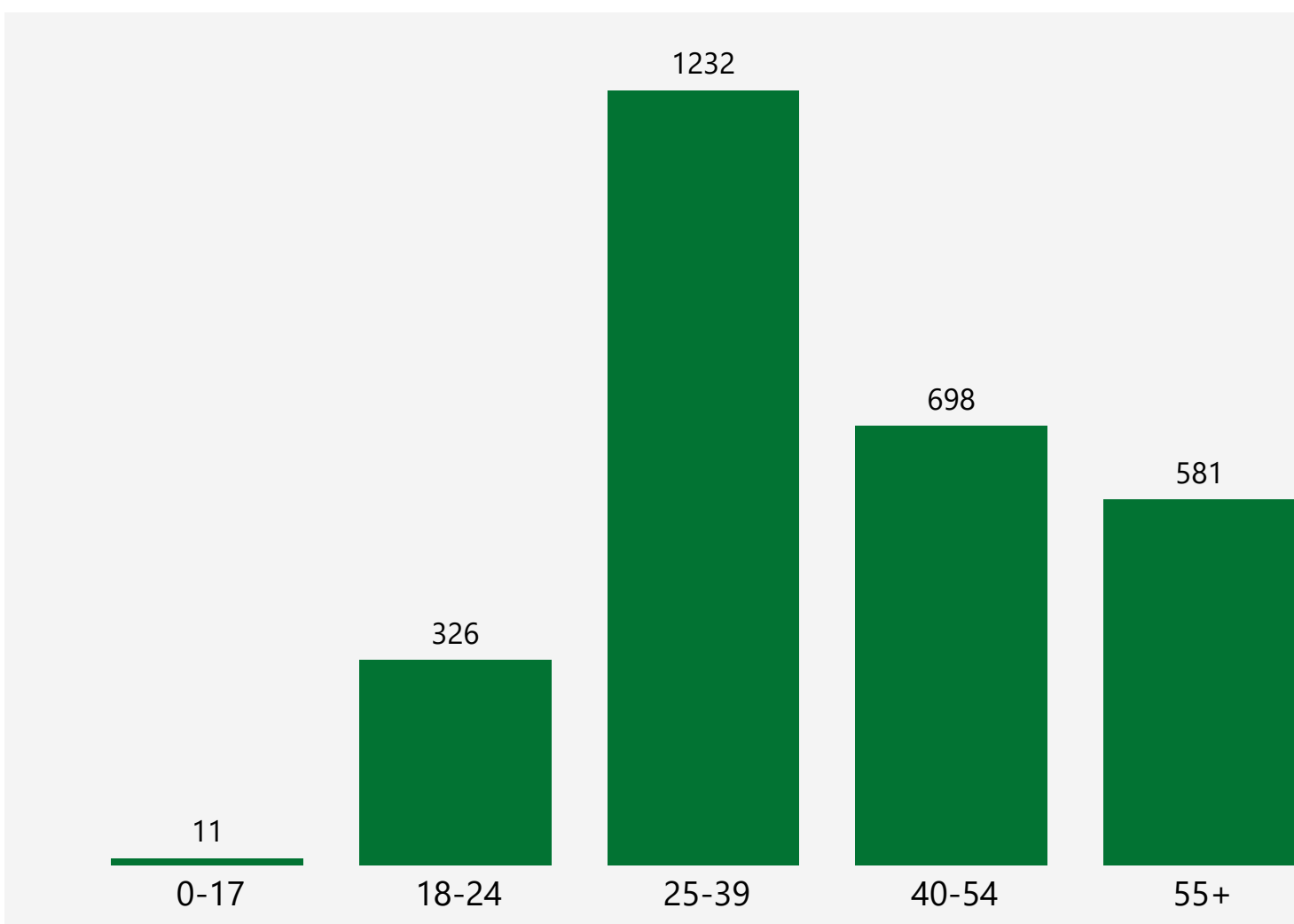


City of Oakland population by ethnicity

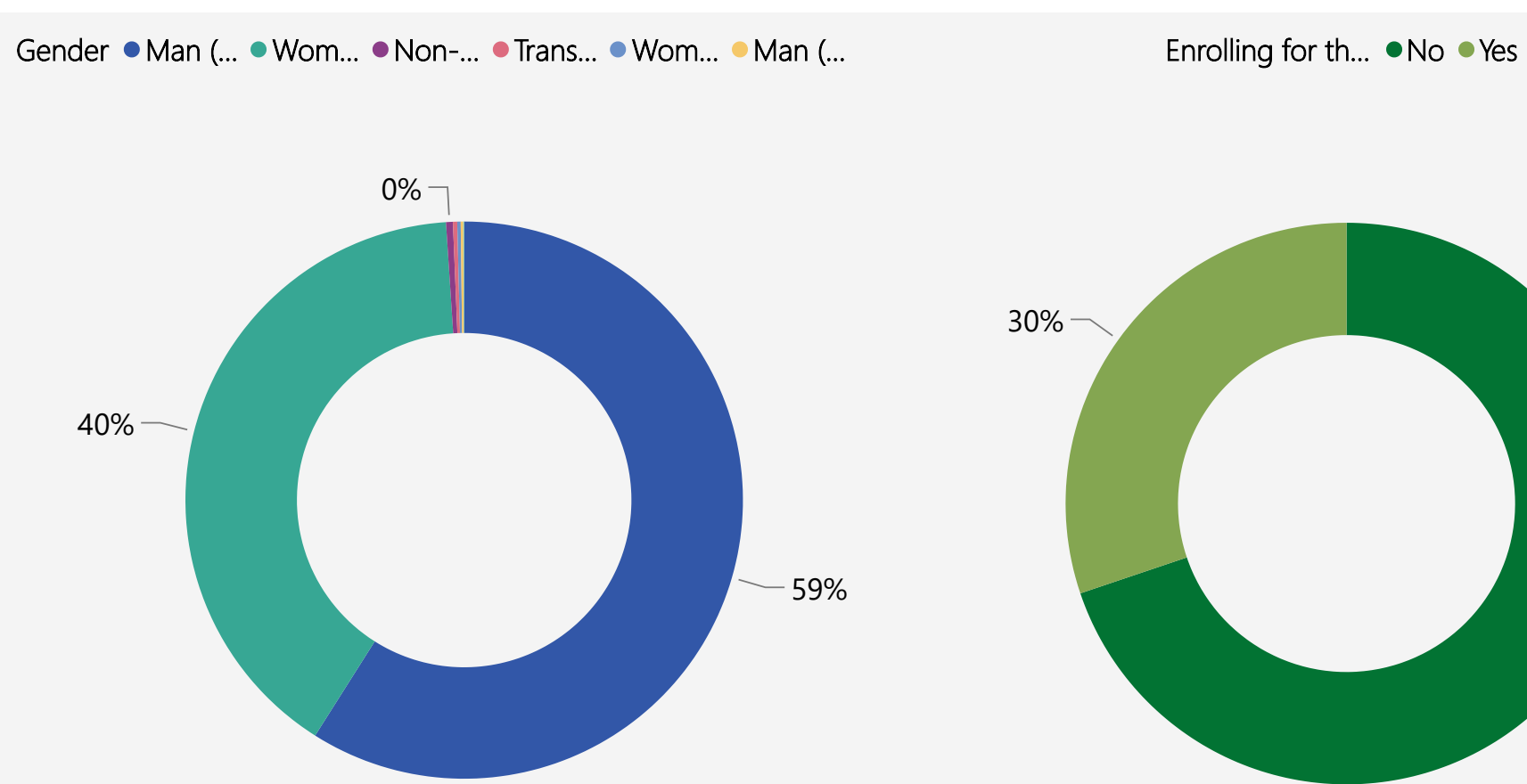

Households receiving services by age

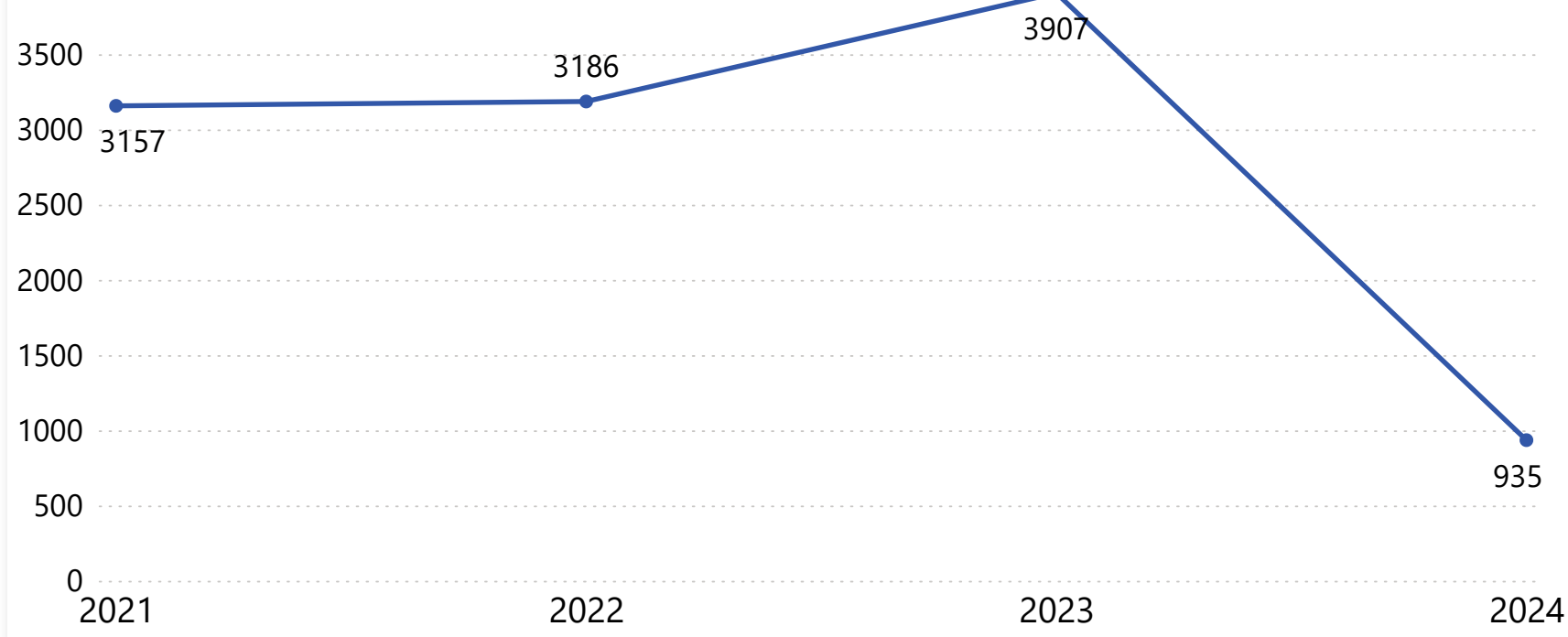


Households by gender
