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**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE REVISED 2023 EMERGENCY  
OPERATIONS PLAN UPDATE FOR THE CITY OF OAKLAND**

**WHEREAS**, the preservation of life, property, the economy, and the environment requires whole-community participation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland is subject to various natural disasters, technological hazards, and human-caused incidents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland anticipates the effects from climate change will include extreme weather with greater frequency and sea-level rise; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Emergency Services Act requires cities to have an Emergency Operations Plan to ensure effective and efficient operations in the event of emergency or disaster; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal National Incident Management System (NIMS) and California's Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS) legislation requires the creation, maintenance, training, and exercising of emergency response protocols by every local government; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Legislature mandated that all such plans be written using the SEMS structure; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Emergency Operations Plan describes how the City will respond to and manage emergencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland hosted 17 publicly accessible meetings from April 30 through September 2021 to inform the public about the EOP and invited the public to comment on the 2021 EOP (referenced now as the 2023 EOP) during 3-months of public comment periods; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** that the City of Oakland adopts the 2023 Emergency Operations Plan attached hereto (Attachment A) and incorporated herein by reference; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** that Emergency Operations Plan will be reviewed, revised, and promulgated every five years or whenever substantial changes occur; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** that changes to the annexes and appendices, and non-substantive changes to the Basic Plan, may be made without return to City Council for approval.
