A SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT REGARDING THE RANKING OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING FIRMS CONSIDERED FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS FOR A TWO-YEAR PERIOD FROM JULY 1, 2005, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2007

SUMMARY

At its meeting of April 26, 2005, the Public Works Committee directed staff to prepare a supplemental report providing the rankings of environmental consulting firms considered for professional services agreements for the two-year period from July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2007. Ten firms were interviewed and ranked during the selection process for the six \$400,000 general environmental contracts. Six firms were interviewed and ranked during the selection process for the four \$200,000 asbestos/lead-based paint/mold contracts.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Following are the rankings of the firms considered for general environmental and asbestos/lead-based paint/mold contracts.
