SUMMARY

On May 17, 2005, pursuant to Chapter 8.28, of the Oakland Municipal Code, an administrative hearing was held to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities prior to the public hearing before the City Council. Each affected property owner was notified of the administrative hearing. Accordingly, three cases were resolved and two were removed from the list of delinquent properties. A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on 5,909 accounts and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges, should they remain unpaid at the time of submission to the County Assessor.

FISCAL IMPACT

Waste Management of Alameda County has billed the City \$751,970.57 which represents monthly charges for October through December 2004 and quarterly charges for January through February 2005. The bill becomes payable after the public hearing is held. Property owners owe the City delinquent garbage charges and administrative fees totaling \$1,051,749.05 for this period. The City will transfer these charges to the Alameda County Tax Rolls to avoid a \$751,970.57 charge to the General Fund.
