A RESOLUTION DECLARING NOVEMBER, 2003 "NATIONAL DIABETES AWARENESS MONTH" IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND
WHEREAS, diabetes is a chronic, genetically-determined, debilitating disease affecting every organ system and which now afflicts more than 17 million Americans; and

<b>WHEREAS</b> , the cause and prevention of diabetes is still unknown and one American dies every three minutes from this insidious disease; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation International (JDRF), the No. 1 nonprofit, nongovernmental funder of diabetes research worldwide has accelerated the pace of medical research and progress along the path to a cure; and
WHEREAS, there is a great need for increased awareness of the warning signs of diabetes; now therefore be it
<b>RESOLVED</b> : that the Council of the City of Oakland does hereby proclaim November as National Diabetes Awareness Month in Oakland and encourages its recognition by all its citizens.
