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Impact of After-School Programs

- 74 schools provide access to free after-school programming through ASES, 21st Century, and OFCY funding
 - 25% of OUSD Students Participate
 - 8,000 youth served daily
- Student receive an additional 15 hours a week of:
 - Academic Support
 - Physical Activity
 - Enrichment (STEAM, Dance, and Culinary)
- Supports OUSD Target Populations:
 - 30% English Language Learners
 - 75% Free and reduced lunch
 - 74% require academic support



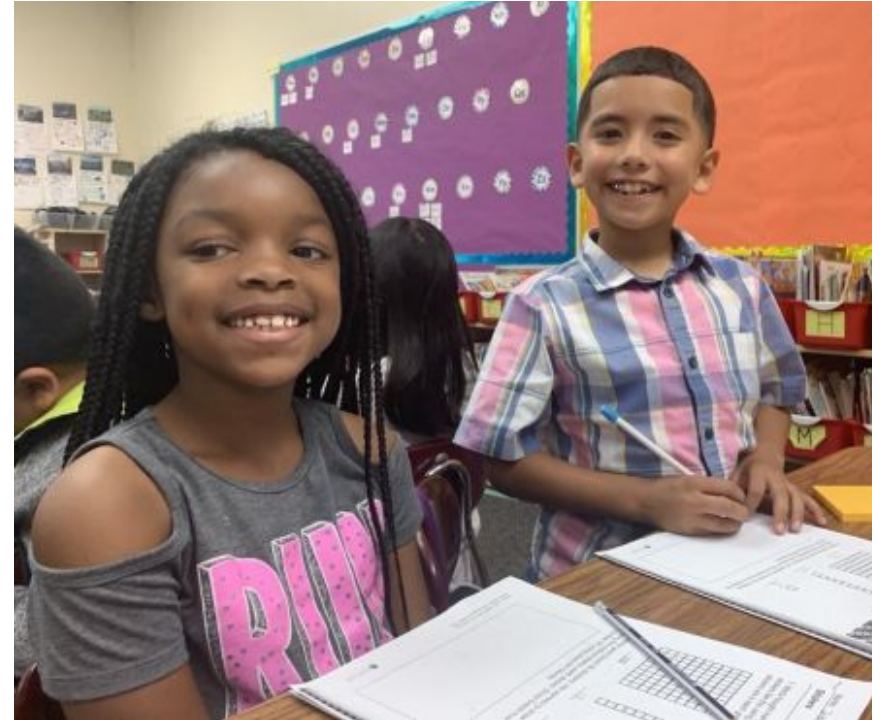
Impact of After-School Programs

- Priority Enrollment for foster youth, homeless, and newcomer students
 - Golden Ticket Policy
- 95% After-school participants attend school at a higher rate than students who don't participate
- Strong Community Partners & Organizations with over 20 years of experience serving Oakland youth
 - Employ over 350 Oakland residents
- Family Engagement
 - Strong relationship with families
 - Host 2-3 Community Events each year



Services to OUSD Students

- 31 After-School Sites Provide Supper
 - 85,897 meals since August 2019
 - Goal for 2020 is 100%
- 60 hours of Coding Activities through the ASES Kids Code Grant
- In Partnership with Bay Area Wilderness Training (School Day and After-School staff) provide outdoor educational experiences to Middle School Students
 - 640 students in 2018-2019
 - Goal 12,500 students for 2019-2020
