**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND THE EAST BAY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION (SAFE PASSAGES) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000) FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2003 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2004 FOR SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE "PATHWAYS TO CHANGE" JUVENILE REPEAT OFFENDER PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department requests authorization to enter into a funding agreement with the East Bay Community Foundation (Safe Passages) in an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004 for services associated with the Pathways to Change Juvenile Repeat Offender Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the agreement will permit the East Bay Community Foundation (Safe Passages) to contract with The Mentoring Center (TMC) to act as lead agency for the Pathways to Change program; and

**WHEREAS**, the agreement will enable The Mentoring Center to subcontract with five community based organizations to provide direct intervention services to Oakland's juvenile (ages 11 – 17) repeat offender population; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for the East Bay Community Foundation (Safe Passages) professional services agreement will originate from the Police Department's General Fund budget: 1010; Org. No.: 102110; Account 54919, now therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into a funding agreement with the East Bay Community Foundation (Safe Passages) in an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, for continuation of the Pathways to Change Juvenile Repeat Offender Program; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Manager is authorized to execute any further documents necessary to implement this resolution; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Manager is authorized to modify, extend or amend said agreement provided that no additional funds will be allocated without prior Council approval; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the agreement shall be reviewed by the City Attorney as to form and legality and a copy placed in the Office of the City Clerk.
