RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Awarding Grants To Sixty (60) Oakland-based Nonprofit Organizations Providing Arts And Cultural Services In Oakland For Fiscal Year 2023-2024, In A Total Amount Not To Exceed One Million Three Hundred Twenty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$1,327,000)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The proposed resolution would adopt the recommended Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24 allocation to award FY 2023-24 Cultural Funding awards in the total amount of \$1,327,000 to the grantees as described in **Attachment A**.

Specifically, adoption of the proposed resolution will authorize the City Administrator to enter into sixty (60) Cultural Services Grant Agreements with sixty (60) Oakland-based nonprofit organizations to provide cultural services that reach all seven of the City of Oakland (City) Council Districts. These organizations support artistic excellence and cultural diversity through the provision of services and programming in dance, music, theater, media, digital, visual, literary, and community arts, while leveraging other government, corporate, and private spending on the arts in Oakland. The grant funds will support over 10,000 individual arts events and activities, most of them offering free or low-cost to the public and will expose nearly 800,000 participants (80 percent Oakland-based) to cultural arts services and programming. This attendance figure includes active participants, on-site audiences, in-person and virtual programming, and estimated internet site visitors. Cultural Organization Assistance activity locations are included in **Attachment B**, and Festival application activity locations are included in **Attachment C**.

BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Program Overview

The Cultural Funding Program (CFP) was established by the City Council in 1985 as the City's mechanism to support Oakland-based nonprofit arts and cultural organizations through an annual competitive application process. These grants infuse Oakland's neighborhoods with arts and cultural activities that increase exposure to, understanding of, and respect for diverse cultural heritages, support arts activities that engage the community, and support hands-on arts instruction in Oakland's public schools. For FY 2023-24, CFP will award grants in two categories as provided below:

- Cultural Organizational Assistance
- Neighborhood Voices for Festivals

The program is managed by the Cultural Affairs staff within the Economic & Workforce Development Department (EWDD). To ensure transparency and public trust in the distribution of public funds for the arts in Oakland, the program has established policies, review procedures, and a panel system for evaluating applications.

CFP staff strive to have a diverse team of community members to serve as panelists - representing various ages, backgrounds, races, ethnicities, sexual orientations, and professions to help City staff evaluate each grant category. The grant review panelists have been selected for their expertise relevant to each grant category. Applicants receive the biographies of each panelist the day prior to the public review panels. As part of the review process, applicants have the opportunity to address the panel for three-minutes. Oakland's CFP is one of the only local grant-making agencies in the State that allows applicants to address the community peer reviewed panel. The applicant's three-minute address is used to clarify any questions or misinterpretations that the applicant may have heard during the panel discussion.

With City Council support, the CFP grants have historically been funded from the General Purpose Fund. In FY 2009-2010, Oakland voters approved Measure C, implementing a Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) surcharge that supplements the CFP funding.

Due to budget cuts across the City in FY23-24, the Cultural Funding General Fund Allocation was reduced from \$1.5M in FY22-23, to \$884,096 for FY23-24. This significant drop in funding resulted in the elimination of two grant categories, including Neighborhood Voices for Organization Projects and Neighborhood Voices for Individual Artists. Cultural Affairs staff made the decision to prioritize the Cultural Organization Assistance program to ensure Oakland's core arts and culture organizations continue to receive foundational, general operating support for their City-wide programming, including work within OUSD and Oakland's most under-resourced communities. In addition, Neighborhood Voices for Festivals, a grant program developed in 2021, activates Oakland's neighborhoods through festival culture - encouraging cultural exchange, economic development and public safety.

Measure C: Transient Occupancy Tax Fund (2419), Cultural Grants Project (1000458) carry-forward funds from FY22-23 may result in additional grant resources of roughly \$300,000.00. If these carry-forward funds are successfully allocated to the department after review by the Budget Office and Finance Department, the Cultural Funding Program will execute an additional grant opportunity to fund community arts programming for Oaklanders in spring FY23-24.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

Grant Review Panel Process

During the FY 2023-24 Cultural Organization Assistance grant application period, the CFP received a total of 31 applications from Oakland-based arts non-profit organizations. Staff reviewed the applications and passed along those that met eligibility requirements per the program guidelines to the grant review panelists. On October 26, 2023, the CFP review panel consisted of a total of 5 community/peer panelists, and they evaluated eligible applications from all 31 applicants.

During the FY 2023-24 Neighborhood Voices for Festivals grant application period, the CFP received a total of 58 applications from Oakland-based nonprofit organization conducting arts and culture Festivals. Staff reviewed the applications and passed along those that met eligibility requirements per the program guidelines to the grant review panelists. On October 24, 2023, the CFP review panel consisted of a total of 4 community/peer panelists, and they evaluated eligible applications from 42 organizations.

Panelists thoroughly discussed, evaluated and scored each proposal based on established criteria. In broad terms, the criteria for the panel review are: (1) soundness of applicant's plan for artistic/cultural services and quality of the artistic product; (2) management ability of personnel and the fiscal soundness of the program or project; (3) the applicant's ability to conduct outreach to targeted audiences and communities; and (4) the extent to which the applicant's activities includes groups and communities impacted by racial and economic disparities. Applicants were asked to address racial disparities and how their programming closes the gap for impacted communities by creating opportunities for them to engage with the cultural programming. Upon completion of the review process and ranking of the applications, staff determined a cut-off for grant awards and the allocation of funds. Applicants receiving an average score lower than 70 (from a possible 100 points) were automatically disqualified from funding. These funding allocations consider the applicants' score, request amount, and budget size.

Staff reviewed scores and ranking of the applicants, creating a list of recommended awards for Council consideration to approve funding for 60 Oakland-based organizations conducting arts and culture programs.

Approval of these cultural funding grants will continue to help advance the citywide priority of **economic and cultural security**. By supporting Oakland Creatives, this workforce will build social cohesion and foster security and belonging through civic engagement activities.

Review Panel Recommendations and Statistics

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost to support these CFP grants will be \$1,327,000, which was included in the FY 2023-25 budget and will be drawn from FY 2023-24 funds available in: \$947,000.00 General Purpose Fund (1010), Cultural Arts & Marketing Org (85511), City Promotion Account (53311), Cultural Arts Grant Fund Project (1000166), Cultural Funding Program (CE02); and \$380,000 Measure C: Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) Surcharge Fund (2419), Cultural Arts & Marketing Org (85511), TOT Surcharge: Cultural Grants Project (1000458).

Of the \$947,000.00 in General Purpose Fund (1010) being used to support these grants, \$83,000 is from phase-2 carry forward funds from FY 2022-23, and \$864,000 is available in the FY 2023-24 Adopted budget..

PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST

The CFP currently has only one staff member, who is responsible for all duties associated with the CFP, including grant applications, public review panels, outreach, reporting, and grant contracting for 106 grantees last year alone. City staff has worked diligently to keep its mailing list and outreach efforts up to date. Email notices were sent to interested groups including City Councilmembers and staff, past grantees, grant applicants and all parties that contacted staff for arts funding opportunities. In total, staff estimates that it was able to outreach to over 1000 organizations and community groups.

The availability and open application period for the FY 2023-24 Neighborhood Voices for festivals and Cultural Organization Assistance grants were announced on July 10, 2023 via press release, social media and posted on the City’s website. Application guidelines and grant category descriptions were widely publicized for seven weeks. Outreach for these grants included posting on the City’s website and social media sites, including the [Cultural Affairs Division Facebook Page](#). In total, staff estimates that it was able to outreach to over 1000 organizations and community groups. CFP staff conducted public workshops and one-on-one technical assistance meetings for prospective applicants from July 2023 through the application deadline. A total of 80 people attended the public workshops via Zoom, and 10 prospective applicants received one-on-on technical assistance from CFP staff.

Throughout the year, an Open Call for qualifications is posted on the [City’s website](#) inviting community members to serve on peer review panels. Grant review panels convened to discuss and evaluate applications in open meetings, where applicants had the opportunity to attend and address the panel with a three-minute statement. Grant review panels were open to the public and accessible through a public Zoom link.

COORDINATION

The City Attorney's Office and the Budget Bureau have been consulted in the preparation of this report and resolution.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: Community-oriented arts activities bolster the cultural arts identity of Oakland, fortifying the City as a destination, bolstering the creative economy and creating positive publicity resulting in economic benefit. In FY 2023-24, the CFP grantees will employ over 2,000 Oakland-based artists. Their activities generate local sales taxes and revenues for the City and local businesses. Many Oakland grantee organizations have received international notoriety and draw large crowds for their performances or artwork.

Environmental: There are no environmental opportunities or benefits resulting from any action outlined in this report.

Race & Equity: The CFP offers an open, competitive process for applicants, resulting in awards to artists and arts organizations that represent all seven City Council Districts. American Sign Language (ASL) interpretation is available for deaf and hearing impaired applicants, language translation services are provided through the City's Equal Access Program, and staff performs outreach in communities with significant Asian-America, Pacific Islander, African-American, Latinx, and immigrant populations. Racial equity goals are advanced through outreach activities that include How-to-Apply Workshops, one-on-one technical assistance that targets under-represented communities, and the recruitment of grant review panelists that represent Oakland's diverse community. The CFP provides support to artists and organizations that serve low-income, culturally-specific, Lesbian/ Gay/ Bisexual/ Transgender/ Queer (LGBTQ), youth, disabled, and senior communities. Furthermore, 34 Festival Activities benefit zip codes 94601, 94603, 94605, 94606 and 94621 which rank high in Oakland's community stressors index; and Cultural Organization Assistance grantees have over 100 (112) on-going arts and culture programs in these priority zip codes.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Awarding Grants To Sixty (60) Oakland-based Nonprofit Organizations Providing Arts And Cultural Services In Oakland For Fiscal Year 2023-2024, In A Total Amount Not To Exceed One Million Three Hundred Twenty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$1,327,000).
