**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR FUNDING, THROUGH THE FUNDING OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT HHS-2021-ACF-OHS-CH-R09-1860 FOR HEAD START/EARLY HEAD START GRANTEE CITY OF OAKLAND, IN AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$17,826,886 PER YEAR FOR A FIVE-YEAR PERIOD FROM FISCAL YEAR (FY) 21/22 THROUGH FY 25/26 FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES, OFFICE OF HEAD START.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland desires to apply for funding, through the Funding Opportunity Announcement HHS-2021-ACF-OHS-CH-R09-1860, for Head Start/ Early Head Start Grantee City of Oakland, in an estimated amount of \$17,826,886 per year from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families (DHHS/ACF), Office of Head Start, to fund the City of Oakland Head Start Program and Early Head Start Program for a five-year period from 2021 through 2026, beginning July 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland, the current grantee of the Oakland Head Start/Early Head Start program proposes to apply for and receive the full grant award, in an estimated amount of \$17,826,886 per year; and

**WHEREAS**, in the anticipated Funding Opportunity Announcement for Fiscal Year 2021-22, which will be issued by DHHS/ACF Office of Head Start detailing the upcoming funding opportunity, funds in an estimated amount of \$17,826,886 annually will be available to provide Head Start and Early Head Start services to eligible children and families residing in Oakland, California; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has learned that the Funding Opportunity Announcement will be released sometime in October 2020 and that the grant application deadline is expected to be in early December 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, funding applications require Head Start/Early Head Start Board approval in the form of a resolution and the City Council serves as the Board of the Head Start/Early Head Start Program; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City, by and through the City Administrator or his designee, is hereby authorized to apply for funding, through the Funding Opportunity Announcement HHS-2021-ACF-OHS-CH-R09-1860 for Head Start Early/Head Start Grantee City of Oakland, in an estimated amount of \$17,826,886 per year for a five-year period from the beginning of Fiscal Year 2021/2022 (i.e., July 1, 2021) through the end of Fiscal Year 2025/2026 (i.e., to June 30, 2026) from the United States DHHS/ACF, Office of Head Start.


