WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency has established the Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund to address the housing needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency desires to maximize the use of the Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund by using all available sources of funds as soon as they become available; and

WHEREAS, actual revenues for Fiscal Year 2001-2002 exceeded the amount budgeted by \$961,957; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency has previously authorized the sale of land at 9451 MacArthur Boulevard and directed that sales proceeds of \$500,000 be deposited into the Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency has received an unanticipated loan repayment in the amount of \$607,721 from the Liberty Hotel project; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency budget for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 includes Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund revenues in excess of appropriations for expenditures in the amount of \$869,323; and

WHEREAS, the Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund has available \$459,796 in prior year funds as the result of (a) canceled programs and/or projects and (b) FY 2001-02 expenditures less than the amount budgeted; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Redevelopment Agency hereby appropriates the sum of \$2,939,001 to the Housing Development Program (Project P209310); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Redevelopment Agency hereby authorizes the reprogramming of \$459,796 in previously appropriated funds, as identified above, to the Housing Development Program (Project. P209310).
