RESOLUTION AMENDING CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 88654 C.M.S. AND 88775 C.M.S. TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH AN EXISTING VIOLENCE INTERVENTION PROGRAM SERVICE PROVIDER (YOUTH ALIVE) BY THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000) FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY RELOCATION SERVICES FOR A TOTAL GRANT AMOUNT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 NOT TO EXCEED NINE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$9,845,000)

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2021 City Council authorized renewal of grant agreements with the existing violence prevention service providers for a total amount not to exceed \$8,560,000 for a third one-year term beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, for the purpose of funding violence intervention services to high-risk youth and young adults (Resolution No. 88654 C.M.S.); and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2021, City Council adopted the Biennial Budget for Fiscal Years 2021-23 (Resolution No. 88717 C.M.S.), which allocated general purpose funds to the Department of Violence Prevention in the amount of \$7,000,000 in Fiscal Year 2021-22 to address the dramatic uptick in community and gender-based violence during the pandemic as part of the City's efforts to Reimagine Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2021, City Council authorized increasing the amount of grant agreements with several existing violence prevention service providers in a total amount not to exceed \$1,155,000 for Fiscal Year 2021-22, for the purpose of funding violence intervention services to high-risk youth and young adults (Resolution No. 88775 C.M.S.); and

WHEREAS, DVP recommends awarding additional funding to Youth Alive, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 for the provision of emergency relocation services; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby amends Resolution No. 88654 C.M.S. to increase the amount of the grant agreement with Youth Alive, Inc. by an additional \$30,000 for Fiscal Year 2021-22; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and related actions which may be necessary for the above referenced grant agreement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said agreements and amendments shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and fully executed copies shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk.


