RESOLUTION NO. 90955 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF GEORGE SEGURA V. CITY OF OAKLAND, AND DOES 1-100, ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. 23CV050672, CITY ATTORNEY FILE NO. 36470, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$125,000.00) (OAKLAND PUBLIC WORKS – DANGEROUS CONDITION)

WHEREAS, Plaintiff George Segura (“Segura”) alleges that on May 11, 2023, Segura was riding Segura’s electric scooter on 40th Street when the scooter’s wheel encountered a sunken utility cover, causing Segura to fall; and

WHEREAS, Segura, who was 60 years old at the time of the incident, alleges that the sunken utility cover was a dangerous condition of public property of which the City had notice; and

WHEREAS, Segura alleges that Segura suffered a fractured collarbone and elbow, and claims past and future medical expenses, lost wages, and pain and suffering; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered all the evidence, litigation costs, and litigation risks in the case and, without admitting any wrongdoing or liability, has determined to pay \$125,000.00 to settle Segura’s claims; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle *George Segura v. City of Oakland, et al.*, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. 23CV050672, City Attorney File No. 36470, for the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars and zero cents (\$125,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Attorney is authorized and directed to take whatever steps may be necessary to effect said settlement.
