SUMMARY

Resolutions have been prepared authorizing the City Administrator, or his designee, to enter into professional services agreements to provide as-needed landscape architectural design services with each of the following eighteen firms:

The Tier I fee category is typically intended for smaller sized firms with a lesser level of experience in the required types of public agency projects. The Tier II fee category is intended for larger firms with a higher level of experience in the required types of public agency projects. Each contract for Tier I will be for an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 and each contract for Tier II will be for an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 over a three-year period, and will be managed by the Community and Economic Development Agency, Department of Engineering and Construction.

As-needed landscape architectural design services are needed to provide site surveying, site evaluations, park planning, programming, design services and construction support services for various City projects. Typical projects include recreational parks, walking trails, athletic fields, community gardens, gateways, memorial sites, streetscape improvements, and other landscape architectural related projects. As needed landscape architectural contracts will facilitate the prompt and efficient delivery of projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

All firms exceed the requirements for Local and Small Local Business participation. The aggregate participation for Tier I is 43% and for Tier II is 55%. Each agreement for Tier I consultants will be for an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, and each agreement for Tier II consultants will be for an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00, for a total of \$5,850,000.00 for all eighteen contracts. The as-needed landscape architectural design services will be required for projects funded by various capital improvement funds, bonds, and grants. The approval of these contracts will not result in the additional appropriation of funds. The services will be funded through appropriations within the various individual projects. Funds will be identified prior to the performance of the design services.

BACKGROUND

In August 2009, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for as-needed landscape architectural design services. Legal advertising was placed in the Oakland Tribune and notifications were sent to certified local and small businesses, as well as all Oakland Landscape Architectural firms listed in the yellow pages. As a response to past concerns by the City Council that it might be difficult for smaller (or newer) consulting firms with limited or no experience in public agency type projects to compete with the larger and fully experienced firms, the Department of Engineering and Construction has been implementing a two tier RFQ process for as-needed consultants, whenever possible. The two tier RFQ process allows for firms to compete more so amongst their peers.

Firms were allowed to respond to the as-needed landscape architectural RFQ in either the Tier I category (contract amounts not to exceed \$150,000) or the Tier II category (contract amounts not to exceed \$500,000). The Tier I category was intended to allow the typically smaller firms with less work experience in public agency type projects to compete independently from the larger, more experienced firms who normally respond under the Tier II category.

Nine firms submitted Statement of Qualifications for the Tier I category and nine firms submitted Statement of Qualifications for the Tier II category. A panel comprised of a one Redevelopment Agency staff member, a representative from the City of Richmond, and a representative from the City and County of San Francisco reviewed and ranked the proposals based on the quality and content of the proposals. The panel determined that all of the firms met the qualifications and requirements outlined in the RFQ. The evaluation criteria for the interview included the following:

1. Relevant experience and strengths of the firm;
2. Organization of firm, availability of resources and capability to meet project schedules;
3. Qualifications of project team and project manager;
4. Meaningful responses to interview questions; and
5. Ability to provide high quality customer service to the City and the community.

The eighteen firms selected are all qualified to provide as-needed landscape architectural design services. Four of the eighteen firms are certified local or small local businesses. All eighteen firms meet the City's Local/Small Local Business Enterprise (L/SLBE) program requirements and will be compliant with the City's Equal Benefits Ordinance. The Social Equity Division of the Department of Contracting and Purchasing has verified the L/SLBE information for each firm (see *Attachment A*). Aggregate participation levels are 43% for Tier I and 55% for Tier II.

The eighteen selected firms have the technical expertise to perform the work required, and clearly demonstrated their understanding of the technical complexities and regulatory issues involved in implementing public capital improvement projects.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

It is anticipated that several capital improvement projects funded by capital improvement funds, bonds, and grants will require the use of as-needed landscape architectural design services. Additionally, unscheduled projects will occur throughout the three-year period and will most likely require the as-needed landscape architectural design services agreements. As-needed landscape professional services agreements allow the City to promptly respond to and provide the necessary design services in an efficient and timely manner. The agreements will also eliminate the lengthy process and costs associated with selecting consultants on an individual project-by-project request for proposals process.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The projects will generate business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City by those firms who work on the project. Local businesses will be utilized on the projects and will benefit directly.

Environmental: Environmental factors and opportunities will be considered and incorporated to the extent feasible. Consultants will be required to consider the use of recycled materials in the products specified and to integrate other environmental, waste reduction and energy conservation opportunities.

Social Equity: The proposed landscape architectural design services for capital improvement projects will result in reducing blight to neighborhoods, and in enhancing various parks and facilities to support increased recreational and opportunities.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

Consultants will be required to design the City improvements in compliance with the physical access requirements of applicable accessibility codes and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

As-needed professional services agreements will expedite the design of capital improvement projects. The time and costs expended in selecting consultants on a project-by-project basis will be eliminated.


It is recommended that the City Administrator, or his designee, enter into professional services contracts to provide as-needed landscape architectural design services with each of the following nine firms for the Tier I category: 1) Bruce Jett Associates, 2) Peter Wolfe Landscape Architecture, 3) Merrill Morris Partners, Inc., 4) Harris Design, 5) Cliff Lowe Associates, 6) Keller Mitchell & Co., Inc., 7) Restoration Design Group, 8) Urban Design Associates, and

9) Questa Engineering Corporation for an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) each, and nine firms for the Tier II Category: 1) Dillingham Associates, 2) Adrienne Wong Associates, 3) Design, Community & Environment, 4) Stantec Consulting, Inc., 5) Golden Associates, 6) Wallace Roberts and Todd, 7) CMG Landscape Architecture, 8) Sasaki Associates, Inc., and 9) Bottomley Associates for an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) each.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract term will be for three (3) years from the date of contract execution; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreement with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation or the allocation of additional funds, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be filed with the City Clerk's Office; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of the agreement will be on file in the City Clerk's Office and will be approved for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney.
