INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH YOUTH ALIVE TO PROVIDE A COMMUNITY SAFETY PATROL FOR THE LOCKWOOD/HAVENSCOURT SCHOOL COMMUNITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000 FROM JULY 1, 1999 THROUGH DECEMBER 31,2000 TO SUPPORT OAKLAND'S DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE WEED AND SEED GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has received a grant from the Federal Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs for the purpose of implementing Oakland's Weed and Seed Plan (OWSP) since October 1996; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution No. 75013 C.M.S on May 25, 1999 and Resolution No. 75485 C.M.S on January 25, 2000 to accept and appropriate third and fourth year funding for the Oakland's Weed and Seed Grant; and

WHEREAS, Oakland's Weed and Seed Steering Committee approved to support Youth Alive's Community Safety Patrol in the amount of \$10,000 per year for two years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland wishes to enter into a professional services contract with Youth Alive to support the community safety patrol for youth and their families en route to and from school within the Coliseum/Lockwood Gardens/Havenscourt and surrounding community; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council finds that the service is in the best interest of the City of Oakland to contract for these services; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a professional services contract with Youth Alive to support the Community Safety Patrol in an amount not to exceed \$20,000 for the period of July 1, 1999 through December 31,2000 to support Oakland's Weed and Seed Grant; and he it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that no position in any competitive service classification will be lost as a result of this contract; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Attorney shall review and approve the said contract prior to execution and a copy of the executed contract shall be filled with the Office of the City Clerk.

DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE WEED AND SEED GRANT.

SUMMARY

On June 6, 2000, City Council approved an administrative transfer of the Weed and Seed Grant from the Office of the City Manager to the Oakland Police Department beginning with the fourth year funding cycle. The Office of the City Manager is submitting this report, in conjunction with the Oakland Police Department, due to a pooled **source** of year three funding, administered by the City Manager's Office, and **year** four funding, administered by the Oakland Police Department, to cover the cost of the contract.

As a **result**, a Resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Manager or his designee to negotiate and enter into **a** professional services contract with Youth Alive! to support the Community Safety Patrol in an amount not to exceed \$20,000 from July 1, 1999 through December 31,2000 to **support** Oakland's **third** and fourth year Weed and Seed Grant.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Youth Alive! contract will not exceed a total of \$20,000 and will expire December 31, 2000. Funding for this contract is provided through City Council's approval of Resolution No. 75013 C.M.S. on May 25, 1999 and Resolution No. 75485 C.M.S. on January 25,2000 to accept and appropriate third and fourth year funding for Oakland's Department of Justice Weed and Seed Grant.
