## RESOLUTION HONORING ANDRE WARD FOR WINNING THE GOLD MEDAL IN THE LIGHT HEAVYWEIGHT DIVISION OF THE 2004 OLYMPICS IN ATHENS, GREECE

WHEREAS, Mr. Andre Ward began his boxing career in 1994 and trained out of King's Boxing Gym located Oakland's Fruitvale District, and;
