SUMMARY

Staff recommends approval to implement the Central City East (CCE) and Coliseum Commercial Security Program walking patrols using City of Oakland police officers on an overtime basis.

The purpose of this supplemental report is to correct a staff error in the original report, which incorrectly stated that the Central City East Project Area Committee (PAC) approved the change in implementation of the CCE Commercial Security Program from private guards to Oakland Police officers. In fact, at its April 6, 2009 meeting the PAC voted with sixteen in favor, zero opposed and two abstentions to reaffirm their February 4, 2008 decision allowing private security firms to act as service provider for the patrols.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The Central City East Project Area Committee voted in favor of the CCE Commercial Security Pilot Program. At its April 6, 2009 meeting the PAC reaffirmed its decision to use private security guards to conduct the patrols. Staff reported this information incorrectly and is issuing this supplemental report to correctly state the action taken by the PAC.

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ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff requests Council to adopt the Agency and City resolutions appropriating Agency funding in an amount not to exceed \$180,000 for the OPD patrols, rescinding Resolution 2009-0047, which authorized a contract for private security services, and amending Resolution 2008-0034 to authorize walking patrols by OPD rather than a private security firm.


