Accept And Appropriate Any Additional Winter Relief Funds From Alameda County, The City Of Emeryville, And Any Other Sources During The Period Of November 1, 2017 Through June 30, 2018; And Amend The Grant Agreements Above To Increase The Grant Amounts, And Execute New Grant Agreements For Additional Winter Relief Efforts For The Period Of November 1, 2017 Through June 30, 2018 Without Returning To Council 17-0220
