SUBJECT:	Public Hearing on Delinquent Mandatory Garbage Fees for Apr/May/Jun 2005, Monthly Accounts and Jul/Aug/Sep 2005, Quarterly Accounts

SUMMARY

The City of Oakland and Waste Management of Alameda County have a franchise agreement for solid waste; yard waste collection and disposal services. In accordance with the terms of this agreement, any delinquent garbage accounts are transferred to the Citywide Liens Tax Compliance Section for recording of liens against the property address. The City of Oakland reimburses Waste Management of Alameda County the unpaid delinquent charges and pursues the delinquent property owner to recover the unpaid charges plus administrative fees. The taxpayer is notified prior to the lien process and given the opportunity to pay or appeal the debt. If the property owner does not dispute or pay prior to August 10th of any calendar year, the Citywide Liens Tax Compliance Section will forward delinquent accounts to the County of Alameda for placement on the secured property Tax Roll for collection.

On November 15, 2005, pursuant to Chapter 8.28, of the Oakland Municipal Code, an administrative hearing was held to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities prior to the public hearing before the City Council. Each affected property owner was notified of the administrative hearing. Accordingly, three cases were resolved and removed from the list of delinquent properties. A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on 6,765 accounts and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges, should they remain unpaid at the time of submission to the County Assessor.

FISCAL IMPACT

Waste Management of Alameda County billed the City \$935,108, which represents monthly charges for April through June 2005, and quarterly charges for July through September 2005. The bill is due and payable after the public hearing proceedings. Property owners owe the City delinquent garbage charges and administrative fees totaling \$1,285,274 for this period. The City will transfer these charges to the Alameda County Tax Roll to avoid the \$935,108 charge to the General Fund and recover the \$350,166 administrative fees. This revenue was anticipated and adopted in the FY2005-07 Policy Budget.


