RE: Public Hearing on Delinquent Mandatory Garbage Fees for July/August/September 2006, Monthly Accounts and October/November/December 2006, Quarterly Accounts

SUMMARY

The City of Oakland and Waste Management of Alameda County have a franchise agreement for solid waste, yard waste collection and disposal services. In accordance with the terms of this agreement, all delinquent garbage accounts are transferred to the Citywide Liens Tax Compliance Section for recording of liens against the property address. The City of Oakland reimburses Waste Management of Alameda County the unpaid delinquent charges and pursues the delinquent property owner to recover the unpaid charges plus administrative fees. The taxpayer is notified prior to the lien process and given the opportunity to pay or appeal the debt. If the property owner does not dispute or pay prior to August 10th of any calendar year, the Citywide Liens Tax Compliance Section will forward delinquent accounts to the County of Alameda for placement on the secured property Tax Roll for collection.

On February 20, 2007, pursuant to Chapter 8.28 of the Oakland Municipal Code, an administrative hearing was held to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities prior to this public hearing before the City Council. Each affected property owner was notified of the administrative hearing. Accordingly, two cases were resolved and removed from the list of delinquent properties. A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on 7,152 accounts and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges, should they remain unpaid at the time of submission to the County Assessor.

FISCAL IMPACT

Waste Management of Alameda County billed the City \$1,890,767, which represents monthly charges for July through September 2006, and quarterly charges for October through December 2006. The bill is due and payable after the public hearing proceedings. Property owners owe the City delinquent garbage charges totaling \$1,890,767 and administrative fees totaling \$454,274 creating a grand total of \$2,345,041 for this period. The City will transfer all unpaid charges and fees to the Alameda County Tax Roll, and payments received through the County will be deposited in the City's General Purpose Fund.

Pursuant to Chapter 8.28 of the Oakland Municipal Code, administrative hearings were held to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities regarding the delinquent mandatory garbage fees prior to the public hearing before City Council.

Collections of delinquent Mandatory Garbage Fees have major economic and social equity implications for the City's sustainability. This revenue source is relied upon to fund essential City services.
