RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH SHAWN LOVELL FOR PUBLIC ART DESIGN, FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION SERVICES FOR THE GATES FOR THE GARDENS AT LAKE MERRITT PUBLIC ART PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$86,000) IN MEASURE DD PUBLIC ART FUNDS

WHEREAS, Measure DD, the Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks Fund, includes funding for improvements to Lake Merritt, creeks, the Oakland Estuary, and adjacent parks; and

WHEREAS, professional artistic design services are needed to develop a public art component for the project; and

WHEREAS, an extensive outreach effort to solicit qualified artist candidates resulted in responses from sixty-five eligible artists; and

WHEREAS, in February 1989, the City of Oakland adopted a Public Art Ordinance (No. 11086 C.M.S.) and an Oakland Redevelopment Agency Resolution (No. 89-8 C.M.S.) authorizing the allocation of 1.5% of City capital improvement project costs for the commissioning of public artwork; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Public Art Ordinance and the Oakland Redevelopment Agency Resolution to provide a means for the City to commission artists to create artwork that enlivens, enhances, and enriches the visual environment of the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2010 and April 8, 2010, a six -member selection panel consisting of community members, artists, arts professionals, project representatives and City staff met to select an artist to create a public art project for the Gates for the Gardens at Lake Merritt, and unanimously recommended artist Shawn Lovell; and

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2010, the Cultural Affairs Commission voted to accept the recommendation of the selection panel and the Public Art Advisory Committee to approve the commission of Shawn Lovell for the Gates for the Gardens at Lake Merritt public art project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland finds that this contract is professional in nature and will not result in a loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; and

WHEREAS, funding for the permanent artwork project in the amount of \$86,000 is available within the Measure DD Series B Bond Fund [Measure DD Capital Improvement Fund (5321), Capital Project Management Organization (92270), Lake Merritt Art – B Project (C396210]; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to negotiate and execute a professional services agreement with Shawn Lovell in an amount not to exceed eighty-six thousand dollars (\$86,000) from Measure DD bond funding; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute any amendments or modifications of said contract within the limitations of the project specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: The agreement will be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
