A REPORT AND—RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO AWARD A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT TO SAP OR AN AUTHORIZED DISTRIBUTOR OF THEIR PRODUCTS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF INSTALLATION, CONFIGURATION AND TRAINING SERVICES FOROF THE SAP CRYSTAL REPORT SERVER APPLICATION—IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED THIRTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000)—IN OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2009, the City Council approved Resolution No. 82377 C.M.S., authorizing the acceptance and appropriation of grant funds in the amount of \$500,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (USDOJ/COPS), FY 2009 Technology Program (COPS Tech) in support of the Data Driven Approaches to Crime and Traffic Safety (DDACTS) program; and

WEHEREAS, on Nov 23, 2009, Department of Information Technology (DIT) published the Request For Quotations (RFQ) seeking to purchase the SAP's Crystal Enterprise Reporting products. basic install services, and first year of annual maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the \$35,000 will be paid out of the DDACTS grant for the SAP Pprofessional Services to install, configure and train the City Staff on the newly purchased Crystal Server Reporting systemapplication; and

WHEREAS, <u>SAP's</u> Crystal Report Server will replace the legacy Hummingbird Reporting software in Oakland Police Department (OPD) by providing a centralized reporting repository and scalable architecture for sharing reports across the department; and

WHEREAS, <u>SAP's</u> Crystal Report Server provides easy and speedy access to information contained in various databases in OPD, and

WHEREAS, <u>SAP's</u> Crystal Report <u>Server</u> will assist in the improvement of the Department's police-community relations and crime reduction efforts through more effective query of criminal databases, as well as overall public safety management of resources; now therefore be it

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has determined that the goods and services provided pursuant to the agreements authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific, or technical

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and temporary nature, and shall not result in a loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service process; and be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or his designee, to enter into an agreement with SAP or an authorized distributor of their products in an amount not to exceed \$35,000 tofor purchase installation, configuration and training services for of the SAP Crystal Report Server; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (USDOJ/COPS), FY 2009 Technology Program (COPSTech) in support of the Data Driven Approaches to Crime and Traffic Safety (DDACTS) will be drawn from the Federal Grant Fund (2112), BFO Traffic Division Org (107510), Account 52213-Project G392610-Program PS14; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council finds and determines based on the above determinations of the City Administrator, that the goods and services provided pursuant to the agreements authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific, or technical and temporary nature, and shall not result in a loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service process; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney shall review and approve said agreements as to form and legality and copies of said agreements shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
