Recommendation: For Cure and Correct Consideration, Pursuant to Government Code Section 54960.1, to Rescind and Re-Adopt an Emergency Ordinance Adopted at the December 21, 2021 Council Meeting, Adding Oakland Municipal Code 8.68 To Require Proof of a Covid-19 Vaccination For Patrons At The Following Indoor Public Locations: (1) Establishments Or Events Where Food Or Drink Is Served Including Restaurants, Bars, Coffee Houses, Clubs, And Banquet Halls; (2) Entertainment Venues, Theaters, Concert Venues, Museums, And Recreation Facilities; (3) Gyms, Fitness Centers And Yoga Studios; (4) Senior Adult Care Facilities And City Senior Center Programs; (5) City Hall; And (6) Large Indoor Events At City And Privately-Owned Facilities 22-0044
