### NOTICE AND DIGEST

ORDINANCE AMENDING OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING CHAPTER 18.02 (WATER FFICENT LANDSCAPING ORDINANCE), TO COMMITTE THE STATE REQUIREMENT TO PROMOTE WATER CONSERVATION AND EFFICIENT USE OF WATER IN LANDSCAPING, AND ADOPTING APPROPRIATE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) FINDINGS

The State of California has established provisions to promote water conservation and efficient use of water in landscaping through the Model Water Efficient Landscaping through the Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance (WELO) as amended September 15, 2015. Senate BIII (SB) 1383, the Short-Lived Climate Politant Reduction Act of 2016, established methane emissions reduction targets in a Statewide effort to reduce emissions of short-lived climate, and, as implemented by the regulations of the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecyle), to achieve the goals of SB 1383, including adopting, implementing and enforcing the WELO or a more stringent ordinance. The City of Qakland is adopting the WELO pursuant to this requirement.
