ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OAKLAND MUNCIPAL CODE TO ADD CHAPTER 1.06 TO TITLE 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS, TO ESTABLISH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR AN OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER AND THE PROCEDURES FOR THE CITY COUNCIL TO DESIGNATE ONE OR MORE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHARTER SECTION 1205.

On March 3, 2020, voters approved Measure R, amending the Oakland City Charter to allow the City Council to establish official newspaper criteria via ordinance. This ordinance allows the City Council to designate digital publications or platforms as the newspaper industry continues to evolve and Oaklanders increasingly receive their news from digital sources, while still preserving traditional printed newspapers as a method of advertisement for official City notices. This ordinance establishes the criteria and procedures for the City Council to designate by resolution newspapers to be used for the advertising of official City of Oakland notices. This ordinance also directs the City Administrator to establish a City website where all official City of Oakland notices will be viewable.

Notice of Publication

This Ordinance was introduced at the City Council meeting, Tuesday evening DECEMBER 21, 2021, and passed to print 8 AYES. Final adoption has been scheduled for the City Council meeting Tuesday evening APRIL 19, 2022 1:30 p.m., VIA Teleconference.
