INTRODUCED BY PRESIDENT PRO TEM THAO and COUNCILMEMBER KALB

**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CALIFORNIA STATE ASSEMBLY BILL 2517 (BONTA),
IT TAKES A VILLAGE ACT, WHICH WOULD CREATE A COORDINATED
NEIGHBORHOOD AND COMMUNITY SERVICES GRANT PROGRAM TO
IMPLEMENT AND STRENGTHEN NEIGHBORHOOD AND REGIONAL CRADLE TO
CAREER NETWORKS TO REDUCE INEQUITIES AND INCREASE ECONOMIC
MOBILITY THROUGH INTEGRATED PLACE-BASED SUPPORT SYSTEMS**

WHEREAS, California spends over \$200 billion annually on services to children and their families including grants, food assistance and other necessary services; and

WHEREAS, despite these critical dollars California has invested, persistent educational achievement gaps, health and racial disparities remain; and

WHEREAS, for the last 10 years, Promise Neighborhoods and other neighborhood and regional networks have provided services in disadvantaged communities; and

WHEREAS, these networks coordinate services across both private and public sectors using a place-based, cradle to career approach; and

WHEREAS, neighborhood and regional networks have produced improvements in healthcare, literacy, college and career readiness and reductions in child welfare and involvement in the juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, California State Assembly Bill 2517 will support children and families by funding neighborhood networks that leverage cross-sector community partners, prioritize systems change to positively effect distressed communities and use data to identify needs and implement solutions; and

WHEREAS, California State Assembly Bill 2517 will create a two-year California Coordinated Neighborhood and Community Services grant program to support the work of neighborhood and regional networks; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council hereby endorses California State Assembly Bill 2517 (Bonta) and urges the California State Legislature and Governor Gavin Newsom to support its enactment into law.
