NOTICE AND DIGEST

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LIMITED PUBLIC FINANCING ACT (O.M.C. CHAPTER 3.13) AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY AUDITOR TO EX-TEND THE DEADLINE FOR CANDIDATES TO DE-POSIT DISBURSEMENT CHECKS AND TO DE-LETE THE MANDATORY AUDIT REQUIREMENT AND REPLACE IT WITH A DISCRETIONARY AU-DIT PROVISION

This Ordinance will amend Chapter 3.13 of the City's Municipal Code entitled "Limited Public Financing Act" as recommended by the City Auditor to extend the deadline for candidates to deposit disbursement checks from three business days to 30 calendar days. The Ordinance also will delete the mandatory audit requirement and replace it with a discretionary one.

This Ordinance was introduced at the City Council meeting, Tuesday evening May 3, 2022, and passed to print 8 Ayes. Final adoption has been scheduled for the City Council meeting Tuesday evening May 3, 2022, 1:30 p.m., VIA Teleconference.
