INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL PRESIDENT NIKKI FORTUNATO BAS

RESOLUTION AWARDING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000 FROM THE CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 MURAL FUNDING TO ARTOGETHER FOR A COMMUNITY MURAL ON THE SAN ANTONIO PARK TENNIS COURTS WALL AT 1701 E. 19TH STREET, WITH THE SUPPORT OF ARTIST CECE CARPIO

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 88783 C.M.S., which amended Resolution No. 88717 C.M.S., the adoption of the FY 2021-23 Biennial Budget adjustments, to appropriate additional funding for murals across the City of Oakland, business improvement district support, cameras in commercial corridors, transportation, and capital projects; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 88783 C.M.S., each Council District office was allocated \$60,000 for public art murals, to be funded by Fund 5505 in the Department of Economic and Workforce Development; and

WHEREAS, the mural funding is allocated to Municipal Capital Improvement: Public Arts Fund (5505), Public Art Organization (85521), Pub Art Mural Fund 5505 Project (1006167), Public Art Program (CE01); and

WHEREAS, Council President Bas wishes to grant \$5,000 of her public art mural funding to District 2-based non-profit ARTogether, who will work with artist Cece Carpio, for a mural on the San Antonio Park Tennis Courts wall at 1701 E. 19th Street in District 2 in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, at the January 12, 2022 meeting of Oakland's Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, the Commission unanimously approved the request to initiate a community participatory mural project at the San Antonio Park Tennis Courts wall; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2022, the mural design was presented to members of Oakland's Public Art Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Park Tennis Courts wall is located on City of Oakland property and managed by the City of Oakland Parks, Recreation and Youth Development

Department, who will execute a License Agreement for the project with ARTogether and Cece Carpio, and provide the approval to install the mural on the wall; and

WHEREAS, the mural project reflects a collaborative effort by community partners and local government to activate and improve cleanliness, beauty, safety, and community development in the heart of District 2's San Antonio neighborhood by promoting community building and participatory engagement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council awards a grant in the amount of \$5,000 from the City Council District 2 mural funding, pursuant to Resolution No. 88783 C.M.S., to ARTogether, for a mural on the San Antonio Park Tennis Courts wall at 1701 E. 19th Street, with the support of artist Cece Carpio; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to execute a grant agreement with ARTogether for the above purpose, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.


