Supplemental Report on Resolution Awarding Construction Contracts For As-Needed On-Call Construction Services To Fourteen Pre-Qualified Contractors Shown In Exhibit A For An Amount Not-To-Exceed Two Hundred And Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) Each For Tier I Or \$500,000.00 For Tier II For A Three-Year Period, And Waiving The Advertising Requirements Of Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 2.04 For

Specific On-Call Construction Jobs To Be Let To Said Contractors

SUMMARY

On December 14, 2010, staff presented the resolution to award construction contracts for asneeded on-call construction services to fourteen Pre-qualified contractors for an amount not-to exceed two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (250,000.00 each for tier 1 or \$500,000.00 for tier 11 for a three-year period, and waiving the advertising requirements of Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 2.04 for specific on-call construction jobs to be awarded to said contractors to the Public Works Committee. The committee requested information on contract compliance.

In addition, the Rules Committee on December 16, 2010 requested clarification on prequalification. This supplemental report is in response to those requests.

1. Contract Compliance:

Peters Construction submitted a Schedule E that did not specify the sub-contractors to be used on the project. Staff contacted Peters Construction and requested that they specify the sub-contractors. Peters Construction has submitted revised documents that have been attached to this report.

2. Pre-qualification Process:

The pre-qualification process is used to establish a list of contractors pre-qualified to perform certain specific work, in this case general concrete sidewalk repair work, streamlines method by which we select pre-qualified contractors to perform repair of curb ramps and small sewer work and in response to citizens' complaints in a timely manner. This is not a contractor rotation program as proposed for consideration by Council. All qualified contractors will be solicited for bids at the same time, and work is expected to begin in spring 2011. We hope that this has clarified your concerns.
