**Comments:** As noted above, all firms failed to meet the minimum 50% L/SLBE Trucking participation requirement. Beliveau Engineering, Bay Construction and Wickman Development & Construction exceeded the minimum 50% L/SLBE participation requirement. Stockbridge General Contracting, Inc. failed to meet the minimum 50% L/SLBE requirement. Therefore, all firms are non-responsive to both requirements.
