RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY PAYMENT PROGRAMS BEGINNING WITH FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023 AND EFFECTIVE UNTIL RESCINDED BY THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq., 14581, and 42023.1(g), the State of California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has established various payment programs to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of the payment programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland (City) has relied on these payment programs to fund various recycling activities including promoting beverage-container recycling and providing recycling-focused technical assistance to City residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle requires, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle payment programs; and

WHEREAS, Council Resolution No. 86914 C.M.S. that previously allowed the City Administrator to apply for and appropriate funds from such payment programs has expired; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to submit application(s) to CalRecycle for payment programs offered; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City all payment program documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and annual reports; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate the funds to the California Department of Conservation Fund (2139), Environmental Services: Recycling Solid Waste Organization (30682), Recycling and Solid Waste Program (SCl7), in a Project Account to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That this authorization is effective until rescinded by the City Council; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney's Office has reviewed this resolution for form and legality and that a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the City Clerk.
