RG19030982, CITY ATTORNEY FILE NO. 33141, IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$65,000.00) (DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - DANGEROUS CONDITION OF PUBLIC PROPERTY)

**WHEREAS,** Plaintiff filed Alameda County Superior case number RG19030982, against the City of Oakland, alleging a claim for dangerous condition of public property; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered all the evidence, litigation costs, and litigation risks in this case; and

WHEREAS, the City admits no wrongdoing or liability; and

WHEREAS, the parties and their legal counsel have negotiated a fair and reasonable settlement of these claims; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of Kate Didech v. City of Oakland, and DOES 1 through 20, Inclusive, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG19030982, City Attorney's File No. 33141, for the sum of Sixty Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$65,000.00); and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take steps that may be necessary to effect said settlement.
