RESOLUTION:

- 1) AWARDING A GRANT AGREEMENT TO SERVICE OPPORTUNITY FOR SENIORS TO ADMINISTER THE MEALS ON WHEELS FOOD DELIVERY PROGRAM FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$170,000) IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY COUNCIL BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS AND ALLOCATIONS AS ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION NO. 89377 C.M.S; AND
- 2) AWARDING A GRANT AGREEMENT TO DEPUTY SHERIFFS'
 ACTIVITIES LEAGUE TO ADMINISTER THE DIG DEEP FOOD FARM
 PROGRAM FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED
 SEVENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$170,000) IN ACCORDANCE WITH
 CITY COUNCIL BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS AND ALLOCATIONS AS
 ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION NO. 89377 C.M.S

WHEREAS, June 24, 2021, the City Council adopted the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-23 biennial budget (Resolution No. 88721 C.M.S.), which appropriated funds for the expenditures proposed by said budget; and

WHEREAS, in May and June 2022, the City Council reviewed the City's revenues and expenditures as part of the midcycle budget review process and, on June 30, 2022, adopted FY 2022-23 Midcycle Budget Adjustments to balance the FY 2021-23 biennial budget (Resolution No. 88721 C.M.S.); and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 89377 C.M.S., which among other things, amended the FY 2022-23 Midcycle Budget and included grant funding to be issued to community-based organizations to provide urgently needed food delivery services to help protect community health and safety, increase equity, reduce vulnerabilities and negative impacts on our community, increase local economic opportunity, and other needs for hard-hit communities; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 89377 C.M.S, which among other things, appropriated three hundred and forty thousand dollars (\$340,000) to allocate to food delivery programs; and

WHEREAS, The Meals on Wheels program, provided by the Service Opportunity for Seniors organization, delivers nutritious meals to homebound seniors and supports the equitable treatment of senior populations with language, cultural, and other critical needs; and

WHEREAS, The Dig Deep Farms Food Program, provided by the Deputy Sheriffs' Activities League, is a food delivery program and partner of the All In Eats program, an Alameda County program that provides Alameda County residents with healthy, affordable food that is locally sourced; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to expedite the issuance of these grants and contracts to improve the lives of Oakland community members; and

WHEREAS, the needs of Oakland residents impacted by COVID-19, and broader health, safety and economic issues are great, and the City must act quickly to address these needs; and

WHEREAS, compliance with the competitive processes required by O.M.C. sections 2.04.040 will delay purchases and the award of contracts to address the negative impacts of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to provide grant funding to the following entities for various community-related services and activities in the specified amounts for Fiscal Year 2022-23:

FURTHER RESOLVED: That these agreements are not professional services contracts as defined by City ordinance as they do not provide goods or services to the City but rather, they are grants to private non-profit entities that serve the public at large, therefore the competitive request for proposal/qualifications process is not required under Oakland Municipal Code section 2.04.015; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That prior to execution, all contracts and grant agreements shall be reviewed and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, and executed copies shall be filed with the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
