WHEREAS, Plaintiff Carolyn Levy alleges that Plaintiff tripped and fell on an uplifted portion of sidewalk while walking on 3rd Street between Clay Street and Washington St.; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff filed Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG18913570 against the City alleging a claim for dangerous condition of public property and seeking general and economic damages for injuries Plaintiff sustained; and

WHEREAS, the City has considered all the evidence, litigation costs, and litigation risks in this case; and

WHEREAS, without admitting wrongdoing or liability, the City has determined to compromise Carolyn Levy's claim against it for the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$200,000.00); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of Carolyn Levy v. City of Oakland and DOES 1-100, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG18913570, for the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars and no Cents (\$200,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement.
