FACTS/ISSUES:

On January 24, 2022, a City sewer main below the intersection at 5 Monte Cresta Avenue and Kelton Court allegedly became blocked, causing raw sewage to back up into the toilet and bathtub of Plaintiff California Capital Insurance Company's ("CCIC") insured's apartment. Raw sewage allegedly backed up into the kitchen, living room, dining room and bedroom of Unit 107 of the apartment complex. CCIC claims it paid \$64,605.83 to repair real property damage to its insured's apartment. CCIC also claims prejudgment interest, attorneys' fees and costs. The City has determined that settlement in the amount of \$64,605.83 to CCIC, without admitting liability and to avoid further litigation, is in the best interest of the City.
