RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 89376 C.M.S. WHICH AWARDED GRANTS TO COMMUNITY SERVICE PROVIDERS TO:

1) ADD FRIENDS OF THE OAKLAND BRANCH, A CALIFORNIA NONPROFIT CORPORATION AS THE FISCAL SPONSOR FOR GRANTEE "NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF COLORED PEOPLE (NAACP)" FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000); AND

2) ADD INADVANCE, A CALIFORNIA NONPROFIT CORPORATION AS THE FISCAL SPONSOR FOR GRANTEE "SABA GROCERS INITIATIVE" FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000); AND

3) CORRECT THE NAME OF "P.L.A.C.E. (PEOPLE LINKING ART COMMUNITY & ECOLOGY)" TO PLACE (PEOPLE LINKING ART COMMUNITY AND ECOLOGY) FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000); AND

4) CORRECT THE NAME OF "HCEB" TO HOUSING CONSORTIUM OF THE EAST BAY FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000); AND

5) CORRECT THE NAME OF "NATIVE AMERICAN HEALTH CENTER" TO NATIVE AMERICAN HEALTH CENTER, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000); AND

6) CORRECT THE NAME OF "SPANISH SPEAKING CITIZENS FOUNDATION" TO THE EAST BAY SPANISH SPEAKING CITIZEN'S FOUNDATION FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000); AND

7) CORRECT THE NAME OF "CENTER FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING" TO CENTER FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$120,000) **WHEREAS**, June 24, 2021, the City Council adopted the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-23 biennial budget (Resolution No. 88721 C.M.S.), which appropriated funds for the expenditures proposed by said budget; and

WHEREAS, in May and June 2022, the City Council reviewed the City's revenues and expenditures as part of the midcycle budget review process and, on June 30, 2022, adopted the FY 2022-23 Midcycle Budget (Resolution No. 89283 C.M.S.); and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 89376 C.M.S., which awarded grant agreements to community service providers; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 89376 C.M.S did not contain the legal names and/or fiscal sponsors for the Grantees and does not provide the authority to execute a grant agreement with the entities; and

WHEREAS, the National Association For The Advancement Of Colored People (NAACP) is a nonprofit engaged in community services that requires a fiscal sponsor in order to accept these grant funds and Friends of the Oakland Branch, a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, has agreed to be the fiscal sponsor for NAACP for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the NAACP will provide an outreach program with 15 youth/young adults to engage and participate in the Social Justice/Juvenile/Criminal Justice Committee; and

WHEREAS, Saba Grocers Initiative is a community-based organization that requires a fiscal sponsor in order to accept these grant funds and INADVANCE, a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, has agreed to be the fiscal sponsor for Saba Grocers Initiative for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, Saba Grocers Initiative will provide community foods cards up to \$1,200 per to Oakland residents or families; and

WHEREAS, PLACE (People Linking Art Community And Ecology) is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation (California Corporation No. 3480305, EIN 4505509131, and will provide fifty (50) environmental education classes a year; and

WHEREAS, Housing Consortium Of The East Bay is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, and will provide management services of a co-governed interim intervention homeless site; and

WHEREAS, Native American Health Center, Inc. is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, and will, among other things, provide direct job placement assistance, job referral services, and employment training services; and

WHEREAS, The East Bay Spanish Speaking Citizen's Foundation is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, and will provide peer mentorship, academic support and college preparation, civic engagement, and family support to low-income Spanish speaking and bilingual Latinx youth in East and West Oakland; and

WHEREAS, The Center For Independent Living, Inc is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, and will provide in-home supportive services such as accessibility improvements, equipment repair, and assistive technology for persons with disabilities living in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to expedite the issuance of these grants and contracts to improve the lives of Oakland community members; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That Resolution No. 89376 is amended to add fiscal sponsors and correct names as listed below in **Table 1** with additional amended text in <u>underline</u> typeface, and removed amended text in strikethrough typeface:
