WHEREAS, Rupani claims that during periods of heavy rain, the street intersection near Rupani's residence floods. The storm water spreads onto the sidewalk and eventually floods the basement of the residence.

WHEREAS, Seema Rupani filed the above entitled claim seeking payment for said damages; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has determined that settlement in this amount, without an admission of liability, is in the best interest of the City; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the claim of Seema Rupani, City Attorney's File No. C35008, for the sum of Fifty-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars and Zero Cents (\$57,957.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized and directed to issue settlement payments as negotiated by the City Attorney with Seema Rupani; and be it
