WHEREAS, on August 8, 2017, Ricci filed an employment discrimination and retaliation charge with the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission ("EEOC") alleging that OPD had discriminated and retaliated against Ricci because of Ricci's engagement in a protected activity (filing a lawsuit) in violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 ("Title VII"); and:

WHEREAS, the City has considered all the evidence, litigation costs, and litigation risks in this case; and

WHEREAS, the City admits no wrongdoing or liability; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined to compromise Ricci's EEOC charge for the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$100,000.00); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the EEOC Charge no. 555-2017-0106 of Helen Ricci, for the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$100,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement.
