## **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Authorizing:

- 1. The City Administrator To Execute Construction Contracts For On-Call Sanitary Sewer Construction Services That Follow All City Advertising and Competitive Bidding Requirements And Are Awarded In Direct Service of Delivering The On-Call Sanitary Sewer Construction Service For A Duration Of Three Years To The Following Tiers, Without Return To City Council:
  - A) Tier 1 Firms Each For An Amount Not-To-Exceed Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000.00) Annually to Qualified Contractors; And
  - B) Tier 2 Firms Each For An Amount Not-To-Exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) Annually to Qualified Contractors; And
- 2. Adopting Appropriate California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings.

## REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

On March 24, 2023, the City issued a Request For Qualifications (RFQ) seeking to establish construction contracts with qualified contractors for On-Call Sanitary Sewer Construction Services. On April 27, 2023, the City Clerk's Office received ten (10) Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from contractors. Subsequently the SOQs were reviewed, evaluated, and scored. All contractors are qualified and recommended for executing contracts as follows.

Tier 1 (\$7,000,000 Annually):

- 1. Andes Construction, Inc.
- 2. D-Line Constructors, Inc.
- 3. Marinship Development Interest, LLC
- 4. McGuire and Hester
- 5. Pacific Trenchless. Inc.
- 6. Ray's Electric

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Tier 2 (\$1,000,000 Annually):

- 1. Avalon Services Inc.
- 2. Bay Construction
- 3. Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc.
- 4. Murgreen Environmental Company

Each contract is for a period of three (3) years, for On-Call Sanitary Sewer Construction Services that comply with all City advertising and competitive bidding requirements.

## **ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL**

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Authorizing:

- 1. The City Administrator To Execute Construction Contracts For On-Call Sanitary Sewer Construction Services That Follow All City Advertising and Competitive Bidding Requirements And Are Awarded In Direct Service of Delivering The On-Call Sanitary Sewer Construction Service For A Duration Of Three Years To The Following Tiers, Without Return To City Council:
  - a. Tier 1 Firms Each For An Amount Not-To-Exceed Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000.00) Annually to Qualified Contractors; And
  - b. Tier 2 Firms Each For An Amount Not-To-Exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) Annually to Qualified Contractors; And
- 2. Adopting Appropriate California Environmental Quality Act Findings.
