RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That City Council Adopt A Resolution To Authorize The City **Administrator To:**

- 1. Award A Contract To Parsons Transportation Group, Inc. Utilizing A Cooperative Agreement In The Amount Not To Exceed Five Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,500,000) To Design The Broadway Streetscape Project Per The Federal Rebuilding American Infrastructure With Sustainability and Equity Grant; And,
- 2. Award A Contract To Wood Rodgers Inc. Utilizing A Cooperative Agreement In The Amount Not To Exceed Six Million Seven Hundred And Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$6,775,000) To Design The Martin Luther King, Jr. Way Streetscape Improvements Per the Federal Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity Grant And To Provide Baseline Design and Project Management Tasks Associated With California State Transportation Agency Funding; And,
- 3. Adopt Appropriate California Environmental Quality Act Findings.

REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

The staff report dated May 9, 2023 discussed that while the City's Local and Small Local Business Enterprise (L/SLBE) program does not apply to cooperative agreements, both firms, under the direction of the Department of Workplace and Employment Standards (DWES), agree to utilize Oakland-certified small and local business enterprise (SLBE) firms and be subject to a penalty of one and one half times the amount that should have been awarded to small and local businesses if participation is not achieved. DWES has verified that all the proposed SLBE firms are currently certified as noted in Attachment A for Parsons Transportation Group, Inc. and Attachment B for Wood Rodgers, Inc. DWES will monitor these projects to ensure that SLBE participation is maintained through the life of the contract.
